12 13	WHEREAS, the City of Littleton owns and operates a large network of public
14 15	infrastructure; and
16 17 18	WHEREAS, an enterprise asset management system is a critical tool in documenting the condition and maintenance activities on the city's infrastructure; and
19 20 21	WHEREAS, an enterprise asset management system will aid in improving operational efficiency and will provide data to support the development of long-term capital improvement plans; and
22 23 24 25	WHEREAS, city staff have made significant time investment into choosing Cartegraph as its preferred asset management vendor; and
26 27 28	WHEREAS, city staff believe Cartegraph will be a platform that will meet our needs for many years to come; and
29 30 31	WHEREAS, pursuing a five-year term represents a significant cost savings over annual licensing renewal; and
32 33 34	WHEREAS, an additional software component is desired to aid in developing predictive and proactive maintenance strategies; and
35 36	WHEREAS, funding for this purchase will be programmed into the annual budget.
37 38 39	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:
40 41 42	Section 1. Council approves the amendment to the existing five-year term for the enterprise asset management system contract with Cartegraph Systems LLC.
43 44 45 46	Section 2. Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof,

50 51 52 53 54	Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.
