**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,  
COLORADO, APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO AN  
EXISTING FIVE-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH  
CARTEGRAPH SYSTEMS LLC FOR AN ENTERPRISE  
ASSET MANAGEMENT SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Littleton owns and operates a large network of public infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, an enterprise asset management system is a critical tool in documenting the condition and maintenance activities on the city’s infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, an enterprise asset management system will aid in improving operational efficiency and will provide data to support the development of long-term capital improvement plans; and

**WHEREAS**, city staff have made significant time investment into choosing Cartegraph as its preferred asset management vendor; and

**WHEREAS**, city staff believe Cartegraph will be a platform that will meet our needs for many years to come; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuing a five-year term represents a significant cost savings over annual licensing renewal; and

**WHEREAS**, an additional software component is desired to aid in developing predictive and proactive maintenance strategies; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for this purchase will be programmed into the annual budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

**Section 1.** Council approves the amendment to the existing five-year term for the enterprise asset management system contract with Cartegraph Systems LLC.

**Section 2.** Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof,

47 irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases  
48 may be declared invalid.

50 **Section 3. Repealer.** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with  
51 this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses  
52 of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.
