A RESOLUTION OF THE HISTORICAL PRESERVATION COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, ALLOCATING AND AWARDING THE 2024 DOWNTOWN HISTORIC PRESERVATION GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Historical Preservation Commission of the City of Littleton, Colorado, held a public hearing at its regular meeting of October 21, 2024 to consider awards for historic preservation grant funds for businesses located in the downtown historic district;

WHEREAS, the commission found the application for the Sommers Oil Service Station (Grande Station), 2299 W. Main St, meets the following criteria:

1. The Sommers Oil Service Station is in the Downtown Historic District and is a commercial building.
2. The grant is for qualifying work under the 2024 grant program: professional design services/façade improvements.
3. The proposed project will support the preservation and maintenance of the downtown historic district.

WHEREAS, the commission found the application for the Weston Masonic Temple Association, Inc., 5718 S Rapp St, meets the following criteria:

1. The Weston Masonic Temple is in the Downtown Historic District and is a commercial building.
2. The grant is for qualifying work under the 2024 grant program: roofing
3. The proposed project will support the preservation and maintenance of the downtown historic district.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Littleton included \$50,000 for the Downtown Historic Preservation Grant Program in 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HISTORICAL PRESERVATION COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The Historical Preservation Commission does hereby approve the allocation and award of the following funds from the 2024 Downtown Littleton Historic Preservation Grant Program as set forth below:

1. \$20,000 to Eric Hyatt, tenant of the Sommers Oil Service Station, for professional
