**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
COLORADO, ADOPTING THE SOUTH METRO WASTE DIVERSION
PLAN**

WHEREAS the Cities of Centennial, Englewood, Sheridan and Littleton (collectively known as “South Metro”) seek to progress to a system that favors equitable waste reduction and waste diversion strategies driven by data and best practices; and

WHEREAS it is estimated that by 2035, the South Metro region will generate approximately 260,000 tons of waste, with a projection of 221,000 tons being sent to landfills for disposal; and

WHEREAS the South Metro municipalities have collaborated and developed the South Metro Waste Diversion Plan (the “Plan”), a ten-year data driven roadmap to transform how waste is managed across this South Metro region; and

WHEREAS the Plan aims to transition to a more sustainable, circular economy and will assess the current materials management system conditions, collect baseline data, and develop strategies for improved waste management; and

WHEREAS on July 22, 2025, at study session, the Littleton City Council provided feedback and ultimately endorsed the South Metro Waste Diversion Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The South Metro Waste Diversion Plan is hereby endorsed and adopted, in substantially the same form as Exhibit “A,” attached hereto.
