**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
COLORADO, AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LITTLETON AND THE BOARD
OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF ARAPAHOE, STATE OF
COLORADO, REGARDING A FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION FOR THE
LITTLETON BOULEVARD FIBEROPTIC INSTALLATION PROJECT**

WHEREAS the council may, be resolution, enter into contracts with other governmental bodies to furnish or receive government services, to make or pay charges for such services, or enter into cooperative or other joint activities with other governmental bodies; and

WHEREAS the City is undertaking infrastructure improvements to install fiberoptic cable and upgrade traffic signal equipment along Littleton Boulevard from the Littleton Center to Broadway (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS Arapahoe County and the City of Littleton desire to enter into an agreement, in which Arapahoe County will financially contribute to the Littleton Boulevard Fiberoptic Installation Project, and to further define the Parties' roles in relation to construction of the Project and maintenance of the infrastructure constructed, as further set forth in Exhibit "A;"

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth in fully.

Section 2. The Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Littleton and Arapahoe County regarding a financial contribution for the Littleton Boulevard Fiberoptic Installation Project is hereby approved, in substantially the same form as Exhibit “A” and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreement.
