


PROPOSED CHANGES

- Louvred, Shade Structure
 - Dimensions/Material
 - Powder coated, tan steel
 - Area 817 square feet (38' x 21.5')
 - Height 10 feet
- Outdoor Kitchen not visible
 - 2.5ft by 12.2ft
 - Grill with stone surround
- Fire Pit not visible
 - 2.5ft by 8ft
 - Stone surround




South Elevation


EAST ELEVATION




SITE LINES




