- June 5, 2018 – Study Session
 - Council provided feedback and asked for a plan and process
The NGAC Action Plan has been included to address this.

By-Law Changes

- Mission updated:

To support the City Council's vision statement with thoughtful, considerate and insightful recommendations, suggestions and feedback, on matters of City policy that directly impact the attraction and retention of young residents and employees

- NGAC topics updated to better match municipal activities
- Member selection now includes a member from Options High School
- LPS and ACC may recommend new members to Council
- Member expectations now include watching council meetings

March 2019	Committee member interviews and selection
April 2019	First NGAC Meeting
May – September 2019	Board foundational education, Envision Littleton, and work plan development
October 2019 – November 2020	To be determined by committee work plan
December 2020	Council Review and potential committee extension

- Two year trial period with re-evaluation in December 2020
