**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LITTLETON, COLORADO, ENTERING INTO AN
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH ARAPAHOE COUNTY
REGARDING CARES ACT LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIONS**

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2020, the United States Congress adopted the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act, Pub. L. No. 116-136, div. A, Title V (the “CARES Act”), which established a \$150 billion Coronavirus Relief Fund (the “Fund”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the CARES Act, the United States Treasury (“Treasury”) will make payments from the Fund to States and eligible units of local government; and

WHEREAS, Arapahoe County has a population in excess of 500,000 people and therefore is an eligible unit of local government under the CARES Act, and, as a result, the County may request direct payments from the US Department of the Treasury of its portion of the Fund; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 18(2) of Article XIV of the Colorado Constitution and C.R.S. 29-1-203, as amended, the City of Littleton and Arapahoe County have the authority to enter into intergovernmental agreements and authorizes governments to cooperate by contracting with one another for their mutual benefit; and

WHEREAS, the City of Littleton and Arapahoe County are governmental entities, each with authority to provide resources and services to citizens contemplated under the CARES Act as a result of public health emergencies within their respective boundaries; and

WHEREAS, Arapahoe County desires to disburse to the City of Littleton a portion of the CARES Act Fund pursuant and subject to the terms of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

The Intergovernmental Agreement between Arapahoe County and the City of Littleton regarding the CARES Act of Local Government Distributions is hereby approved.
