**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LITTLETON, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING AN
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF
LITTLETON AND THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF COSTS ASSOCIATED
WITH THE REPLACEMENT OF THE SOUTH WINDERMERE STREET
OVER HIGHLINE CANAL BRIDGE**

WHEREAS, the council may, by resolution, enter into contracts with other governmental bodies to furnish or receive government services, to make or pay charges for such services, or enter into cooperative or other joint activities with other governmental bodies; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Transportation and the City of Littleton desire to enter into an agreement associated with the replacement of the South Windermere Street over Highline Canal bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Transportation intends to reimburse the city up to \$1,240,518.00 for the services performed by the city.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

The Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Littleton and the Colorado Department of Transportation for reimbursement of costs associated with the replacement of the South Windermere Street over Highline Canal bridge is approved and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute such intergovernmental agreement.
