7 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
8 COLORADO, AUTHORIZING A SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT WITH
9 ADAMS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO CONTINUE
10 PARTNERSHIP WITH THE COLORADO LOCAL ENTITY AIR
11 NETWORK (CLEAN)

13 WHEREAS, council may, by resolution, enter into contracts with other
14 government bodies to furnish or receive governmental services, to make or pay for changes to such
15 services, and to enter into cooperative or joint activities with other government bodies; and

17 WHEREAS, the City of Littleton desires to continue an agreement with Adams
18 County Health Department for the cost of the installed air sensors and live dashboard; and

19
20 WHEREAS, the cost is \$4,900/year to continue to fund the installed air monitors
21 in the City of Littleton, which are connected to a live regional dashboard and funded through a
22 cost-sharing model through this agreement.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
25 THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

27 Section 1. The City of Littleton hereby approved the updated Intergovernmental
28 Agreement by and between the City of Littleton and Adams County Health Department for the
29 continued support of air monitoring equipment within the City of Littleton’s boundaries, and the
30 mayor is hereby authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreement.
