If Owner attempts to terminate or rescind this Agreement at any later time, On Point shall be entitled to keep Owner's deposit, which shall become nonrefundable upon after the termination deadline set forth herein. Property Owner acknowledges that this termination fee is not a penalty, but is intended to compensate On Point and its employees and agents for work performed in preparing for the

project and lost opportunity costs. Nothing contained in this provision is intended to release Owner from any liability to pay On Point for all actual materials ordered or work performed prior to any attempted termination by Owner and On Point shall be entitled to payment for the fair value of work performed and the cost of all materials ordered. If Property Owner does not rescind this contract within 72 hours after entering into the contract and Property Owner's insurer approves the claim, but attempts to terminate or rescind this contract at any later time, Property Owner agrees

to pay On Point (or allow On Point to retain, if applicable) a termination fee in the amount of twenty percent (20%) of the total contract price. Property Owner acknowledges that this termination fee is not a penalty, but is intended to compensate On Point and its employees and agents for work performed in estimating and working with Property Owner's insurer to seek approval of the claim.

- 2. On Point will maintain its customary insurance, including general commercial liability coverage, automobile coverage and workers' compensation coverage.
- 3. This proposal and contract is based upon the work to be performed by On Point not involving asbestos-containing or hazardous materials and that such materials will not be encountered or disturbed during the course of performing the work. In the event that such materials are encountered, On Point shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all additional expenses incurred as a result of the presence of asbestos-containing or hazardous materials.
- 4. Owner shall be entitled to order changes and the contract price adjusted accordingly. If the scope of work outlined on the face of this proposal does not contemplate such conditions, On Point will promptly report the condition to the Owner and take such steps as are reasonably necessary and prudent to protect the building. Any alteration to or deviation from the specifications described on the first page of this proposal involving extra costs will be billed as an extra charge.
- 5. On Point shall not be responsible for loss, damage or delay caused by circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, weather, accidents, fire, vandalism, pandemic, executive order or any other order of any governmental or quasi-governmental agency, regulation, strikes, failure or delay of transportation, supply-chain issue, shortage of or inability to obtain materials. On Point is not required to remove snow, ice or water from the Property.
- 6. Owner is to carry property and casualty insurance, including coverage for fire, wind damage and vandalism.
- 7. All materials and work shall be furnished in accordance with normal industry tolerances for color, variation, thickness, size, weight, amount, finish, texture and performance standards.
- 8. On Point shall be entitled to file a lien or claim in the event that payment to On Point is not made.
- 9. If a dispute arises between On Point and Owner with respect to any matters or questions arising out of or relating to this contract or the breach thereof, such dispute shall, as a condition precedent to initiating litigation, be mediated with a mediator at the Denver, Colorado JAG office mutually acceptable to On Point and Owner. If On Point and Owner cannot agree on a mediator, each shall select a mediator and the two selected mediators will select a third mediator to mediate the dispute. Notwithstanding the foregoing, On Point may initiate any litigation and take all other steps

required to protect its lien rights and any litigation shall be stayed pending the outcome of mediation. Any claim must be initiated no later than two (2) years after On Point performed the work. If the parties have not resolved a claim within 30 days of the mediation, either party may file litigation, which litigation will be exclusively initiated in the state courts located in the county where the property is located. In the event litigation is initiated related to this contract, the prevailing party in such litigation shall be entitled to collect and the court shall award all reasonable costs

and expenses incurred with respect to the litigation, including but not limited to all reasonable attorneys' fees and expert witness fees. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Colorado.

- 10. Owner acknowledges that the price estimate provided hereunder is based upon the assessment of damage at the time of the proposal and the same is subject to change in the event additional damages are discovered. In such event On Point will seek to work with Owner's insurer to obtain compensation for additional work required.
- 11. If Owner takes any action that inhibits On Point's ability to obtain compensation from Owner's insurer for any work performed on the property and included in this contract, Owner shall be responsible to On Point for payment in full to On Point for all work performed. By way of example and not intended in any way to limit the application of this

provision, if Owner receives compensation from its insurer for any work that is included in this agreement, but decides to self-perform said work and such action results in the insurance company refusing to release funds to On Point to pay for work On Point performed, Owner shall be responsible for payment to On Point for all work performed.

- 12. On Point may terminate this Contract without any further obligation to Owner at any time prior to beginning work on the project.
- 13. Unless otherwise stated, any estimate, quote, or proposal provided to Owner by On Point does not include any city, country, state, federal or other taxes imposed on any material provided under this Agreement. Any such taxes applicable to or imposed on the materials purchased and provided hereunder under existing or future laws, shall be for Owner's account. Owner shall pay all such taxes when due and in addition to the contract price or, alternatively, shall provide On Point with acceptable proof of tax exemption.

- 14. Notice. Any notice provided for herein shall be in writing and deemed to have been given if and when delivered, when deposited in the United States mail, certified, postage prepaid and addressed to the addresses set forth on page 1 of the Agreement.
- 15. Binding Effect. This agreement shall be binding upon the heirs, representatives, and assigns of the parties hereto. Owner shall not assign this Agreement without the prior written approval of On Point.

- 17. The Scope of Work is subject to approval and permitting by the local building dept. Any change to the scope of work required by local regulatory bodies will be submitted to the Customer with an appropriate written Change Order and related increase/decrease in cost.
- 18. Right to Photograph the Work. Owner shall permit Contractor or person(s) employed or engaged by Contractor, without compensation or consideration to Owner, to take photographs at the project site of both completed work and work in progress, for purposes including, but not limited to, publication in newspapers, magazines, and other print media, use in broadcast media, publication via the Internet, and use in marketing materials used by Contractor. Such photographs and any accompanying descriptions shall not identify Owner or the property address of the project without the express written consent of Owner.
