**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LITTLETON, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE
ARAPAHOE COUNTY OPEN SPACES GRANT PROGRAM FOR A
STANDARD GRANT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF TRAIL UNDERPASSES
AND TRAIL CONNECTIONS AT SLAUGHTERHOUSE GULCH PARK**

WHEREAS, the city of Littleton as part of its mission statement acquires and improves land within city boundaries to develop and provide park and recreation facilities for the public; and

WHEREAS, Arapahoe County provides funding for such projects through distribution of its Open Space Grant monies; and

WHEREAS, the city of Littleton has requested \$253,564 for the Slaughterhouse Gulch Park trail connection project, which will construct two multi-use trail underpasses at the Consolidated Mainline Railroad and Rio Grande Street and trail connections from Slaughterhouse Gulch Park to the Littleton Community Trail and Slaughterhouse Gulch Park through Geneva Park; and

WHEREAS, Slaughterhouse Gulch Park and Geneva Park are outdoor park facilities open to the public.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

1. The City Council of city of Littleton strongly supports the grant application for The Slaughterhouse Gulch Park trail connection project.
2. The City Council of city of Littleton has authorized sufficient appropriation to cover the \$84,521 in matching funds for said Arapahoe County Open Space Grant and authorizes the expenditure of funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of the awarded grant.
3. The city commits to completing the Slaughterhouse Gulch Park trail connection project, if the grant is awarded.
4. The project site is owned by the city of Littleton.

46 5. If the grant is awarded, the city of Littleton acknowledges responsibility of cost
47 overruns for the Slaughterhouse Gulch Park trail connection project.

49 6. If the grant is awarded, the city council of the city of Littleton hereby authorizes
50 the city Manager to sign the grant agreement and grant records with Arapahoe
51 County.

53 7. The City of Littleton will continue to maintain the park in a high-quality
54 condition, and in accordance with all terms, conditions and obligations contained
55 in that intergovernmental agreement.

57 8. This resolution is in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
