**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
COLORADO, AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT (IGA) BETWEEN THE CITY OF LITTLETON AND
ARAPAHOE COUNTY OPEN SPACES FOR THE 2025 GRANT AWARD
REGARDING JACKASS HILL PARK IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the Council may, by resolution, enter into contracts with other governmental bodies to furnish or receive governmental services, to make or pay for charges for such services and to enter into cooperative or joint activities with other government bodies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Littleton has received a grant from 2025 Arapahoe County Open Spaces grant program funds towards the Improvements of Jackass Hill Park; and

WHEREAS, the Arapahoe County Open Spaces department has drafted an intergovernmental agreement regarding the grant that requires City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the grant includes a total of \$1,900,000 towards the master plan with Arapahoe County contributing \$600,000 and the city contributing a match of \$1,300,000 partnering with South Suburban Parks and Recreation, as set forth in the Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

Section 1. The Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Littleton and Arapahoe County Open Spaces regarding the 2025 grant of Arapahoe County Open Space funds for the Improvements of Jackass Hill Park is approved, and the mayor is hereby authorized to execute such intergovernmental agreement.
