**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
COLORADO, APPROVING A LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
CITY OF LITTLETON AND DENVER WATER FOR CONSTRUCTION ON
DENVER WATER PROPERTY FOR THE COUNTY LINE ROAD SHARED
USE PATH CONNECTIONS PROJECT**

WHEREAS the council may, by resolution, enter into contracts with other governmental bodies to furnish or receive government services, to make or pay charges for such services, or enter into cooperative or other joint activities with other governmental bodies; and

WHEREAS the City and County of Denver, acting by and through its Board of Water Commissioners owns property for the Board's High Line Canal, within the boundaries of Douglas County, bordering the City of Littleton boundary; and

WHEREAS the City of Littleton intends to construct improvements on a portion of this property as part of the County Line Road Shared Use Path Project; and

WHEREAS the Board and Littleton desire to enter into an agreement, whereby the Board authorizes Littleton to construct, utilize, maintain, repair, and replace a 12-foot wide trail with concrete surface and 3-rail wooden fence pursuant to the terms and conditions outlined in the agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth in fully.

Section 2. The License Agreement between the City of Littleton and the City and County of Denver, acting by and through its Board of Water Commissioners regarding trail and fence improvements on the Board's High Line Canal property is hereby approved, in substantially the same form as Exhibit "A" and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreement.
