25	principles; and to comply with state and federal legislative requirements tied to local hazard
26	mitigation planning;

29	and regulations governing local hazard mitigation plans and shall be monitored and updated on a
30	routine basis in compliance with the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency
31	Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C., Section 322, Mitigation Planning, as enacted by Section 104 of the
32	Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (P.L. 106-390) and by FEMA's Interim Final Rule published in
33	the Federal Register on February 26, 2002, at 44 CFR Part 201; and

35	WHEREAS , the city council finds that adoption of the plan is in the best interest of the health adoption of the citizens of Littleton:
