7 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,  
8 COLORADO, AMENDING THE CITY CODE, CHAPTER 2  
9 ALCOHOL BEVERAGES OF TITLE 3 BUSINESS  
10 REGULATIONS

11  
12 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Littleton desires to update the Littleton  
13 Municipal Code to reflect current regulatory changes as well as Colorado Revised Statutes; and

14  
15 WHEREAS, recently changes were made at the State level concerning types of  
16 liquor licenses that may apply for tastings permits; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, city council wishes to align with state law and regulations adopted by  
19 the Colorado Department of Revenue.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
23 THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

26 Section 1: Title 3 of the Littleton City Code is hereby amended as follows:

28 3-2-21: ALCOHOL BEVERAGE TASTINGS:

30 A. CERTAIN LICENSEES AS SET FORTH IN Pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes  
31 section 44-3-301(10), ~~retail liquor store or liquor licensed drugstore~~ may be permitted to  
32 conduct tastings subject to the provisions of the Colorado Liquor Code and this section.  
33  
34 B. A tastings permit may be issued by the authority upon application by a ~~retail liquor store~~  
35 ~~or liquor licensed drugstore licensee~~ ANYONE HOLDING A QUALIFIED LICENSE  
36 TYPE PURSUANT TO SECTION 44-3-301(10). The application fee for a tastings permit  
37 shall be one hundred twenty five dollars (\$125.00). Any tastings permit issued shall expire  
38 on the same date as the ~~retail liquor store or liquor licensed drugstore~~ license issued by the  
39 City. The renewal fee for a tastings permit shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).

41 Section 2: Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or  
42 phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the  
43 validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would  
44 have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase  
45 hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or

46 phrases may be declared invalid.

48 **Section 3:** Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict  
49 with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the repealer  
50 clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.

54 of the City of Littleton on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2024, passed on first reading by a vote of 6

55 FOR and 0 AGAINST; and ordered published by posting at Littleton Center, Bemis Library,

56 the Municipal Courthouse and on the City of Littleton Website.

57 PUBLIC HEARING on the Ordinance to take place on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2024,

58 in the Council Chamber, Littleton Center, 2255 West Berry Avenue, Littleton, Colorado, at the

59 hour of 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as it may be heard.
