7 **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF**
8 **LITTLETON, COLORADO, TO APPROVE AN**
9 **INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH ARAPAHOE COUNTY**
10 **FOR THE USE OF ARAPAHOE COUNTY OPEN SPACE FUNDS TO BE**
11 **USED FOR THE DESIGN, PERMITTING AND BID DOCUMENTS FOR**
12 **THE RIVERSIDE DOWNS TRAIL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.**

15 **WHEREAS**, Section 67 of the Littleton City Charter allows the city council to
16 enter into contracts with other governmental bodies to furnish or receive governmental services,
17 to make or pay charges for such services, and to enter into cooperative or other joint activities
18 with other governmental bodies;

20 **WHEREAS**, in 2014, the South Platte Working Group (SPWG) and Arapahoe
21 County Open Spaces Advisory Board approved the South Platte River Corridor Planning Joint
22 Project Proposal, which provides funding for approved planning and study projects along the
23 river corridor;

25 **WHEREAS**, Arapahoe County, as part of a joint project with the city, desires to
26 provide funding towards the design, permitting and bid documents for the Riverside Downs
27 project, which is an eligible use of the Arapahoe County Open Space Program funds; and

29 **WHEREAS**, the city council desires to enter into an intergovernmental
30 agreement with Arapahoe County for the Riverside Downs project;

32 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF**
33 **THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

35 The Intergovernmental Agreement with Arapahoe County regarding
36 contribution of Arapahoe County Open Space Program funds for the design,
37 permitting and bid documents for the Riverside Downs trail improvement project
38 is hereby approved.
