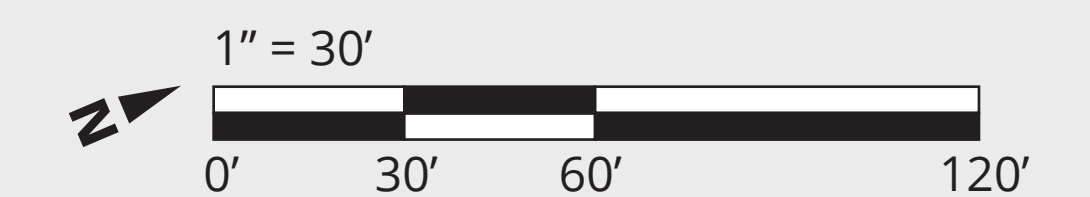

This is more than a venue — it's a community landmark that belongs to Littleton.















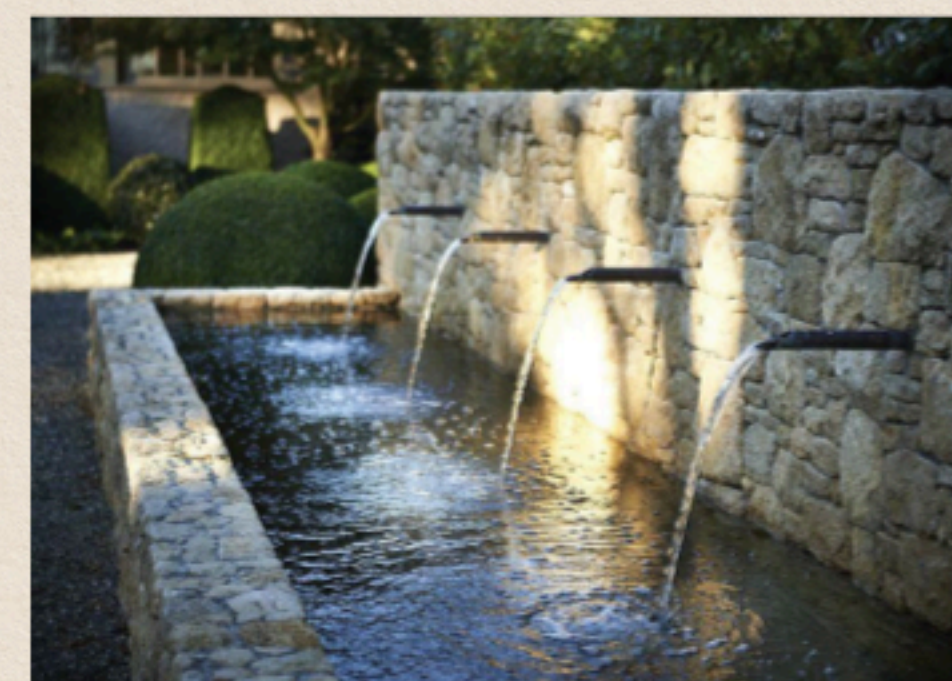
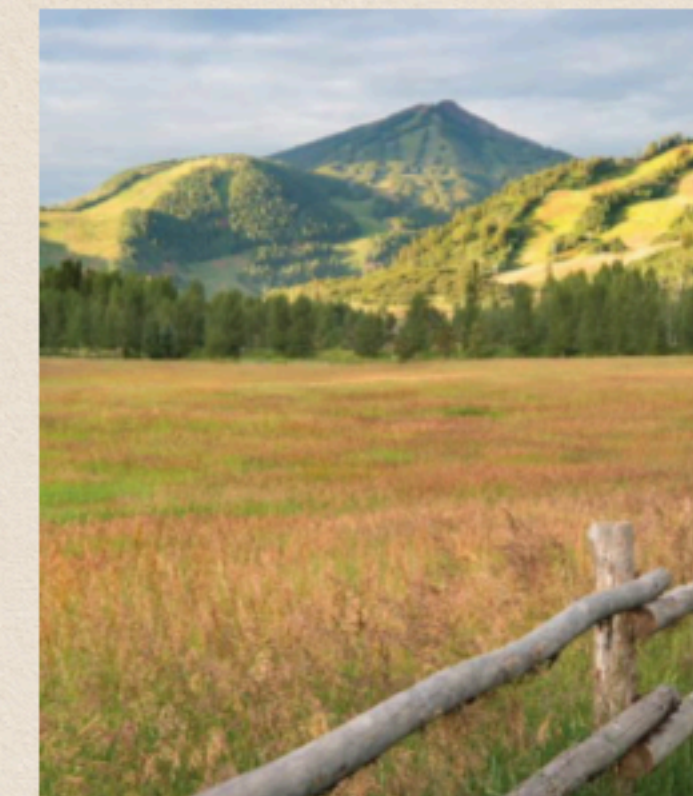






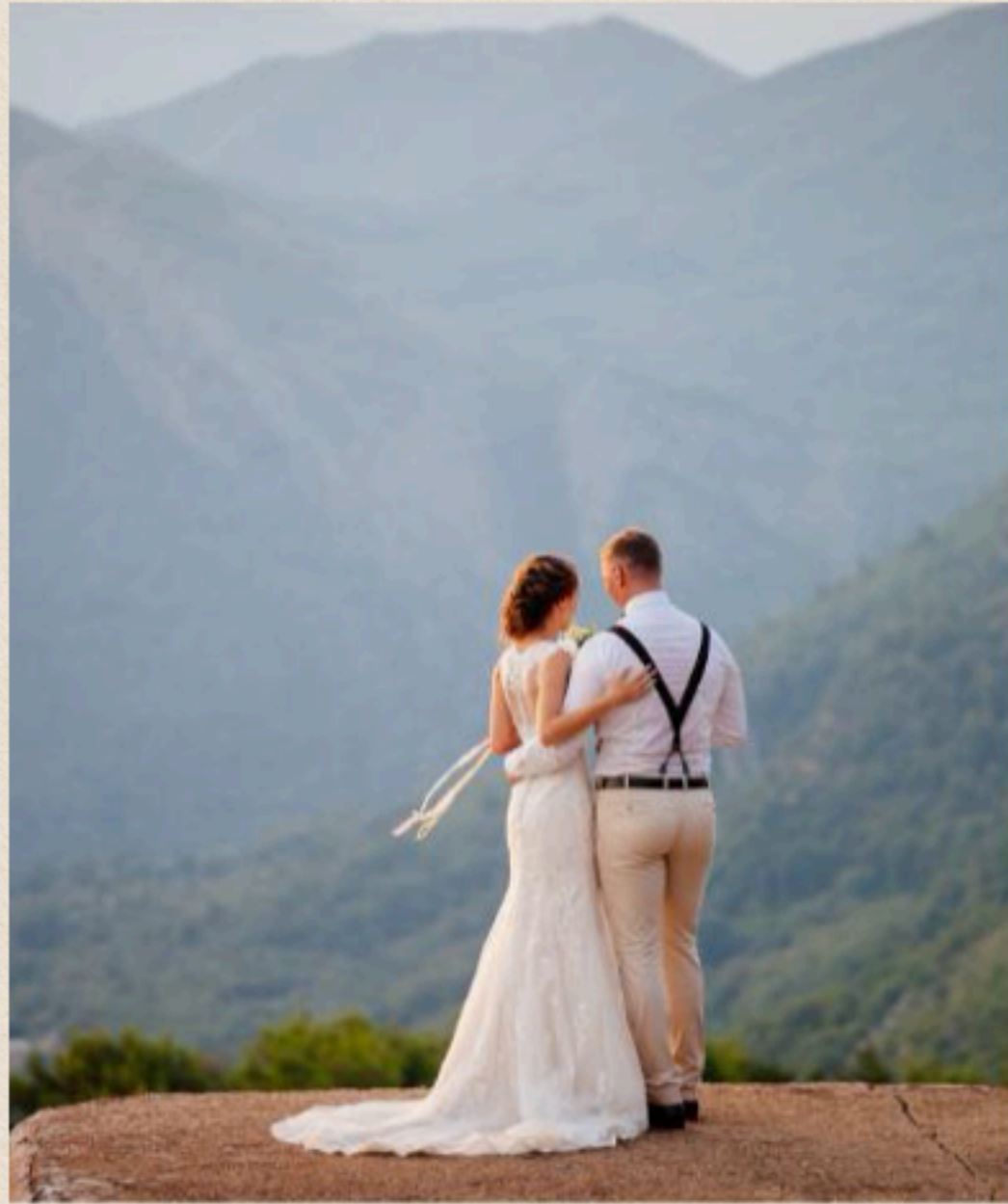

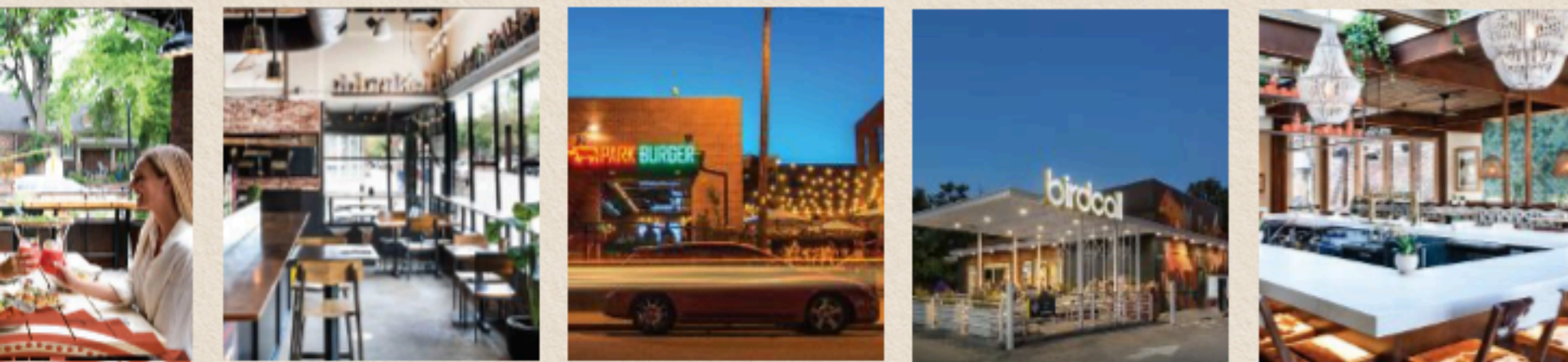


Gastamo Group

Over the years, Gastamo has grown into a family of five distinctive concepts — Park Burger, Homegrown Tap & Dough, Park & Co., Perdida, and Lady Nomada. Our focus remains entirely on Colorado because of our love for this state, its people, and the communities we serve. Staying close to home allows us to refine operations, support our teams, and be present in every restaurant — sometimes all in the same day. Gastamo was built for the people of Colorado, and we remain committed to growing only here, where we can execute with excellence and make an impact that lasts.

Recognized as one of the Top 25 Restaurant Groups in America by Nation's Restaurant News, Gastamo has established itself as a trusted operator with a proven track record of success. The name "Gastamo" comes from Esperanto, the universal language, and translates to hospitality — a value at the heart of everything we do. FOUNDER OF GASTAMO GROUP

Jean-Philippe Failyau is the Founder of Gastamo Group, one of Denver's leading hospitality companies and a Top 25 Restaurant Group in America, as recognized by Nation's Restaurant News.

In 2009, Failyau launched Park Burger to meet a growing demand for high-quality, approachable dining in Denver. That single neighborhood concept laid the foundation for Gastamo Group, which now includes 13 company-owned restaurants—with three more in development—across five original concepts: Park Burger, Park & Co., Homegrown Tap & Dough, Perdida, and Lady Nomada.

Under his leadership, Gastamo has achieved sustained comp sales growth, expanded margin efficiency, and implemented scalable labor and operational models—all while navigating the industry's most volatile years.

Failyau's background blends culinary excellence with strategic entrepreneurship. Originally from Belgium, he trained at the French Culinary Institute in New York City and worked in acclaimed kitchens such as Daniel, JoJo, and Le Cirque 2000. After relocating to Denver, he was instrumental in opening Osteria Marco alongside restaurateur Frank Bonanno.

With over 20 years of hospitality experience, Failyau brings a chef's passion, an operator's precision, and a founder's vision to every concept he leads.

Peter John Newlin is the CEO and partner of Gastamo Group, the Denver-based hospitality and real estate company behind Park Burger, Homegrown Tap & Dough, Perdida - Mexican Kitchen, Park & Co, and Lady Nomada. A lifelong innovator, Peter created the Poncho custom POS platform for the Birdcall concept, which sparked Gastamo's early focus on complementary technology tools to elevate food quality while reducing prices.

Newlin's current frontier is AI-driven leadership. Colleagues say he, "makes AI click for operators who'd rather see labor costs drop than learn buzzwords," and turns data models into "real EBITDA." He distills predictive insights that cut costs, boost margins, and wow guests, and now speaks nationwide on preparing leaders for an AI-first future—believing the best way to learn is to teach.

A College of Charleston grad with an MBA from the University of Denver, Newlin co-founded the Denver Deluxe Music & Arts Festival and Fuel Hope Kitchen, which served 250k meals during the pandemic. He sits on the boards of Eat Denver and YPO Rocky Mountain and has been recognized as a Denver Business Journal 40 Under 40 honoree and a Titan 100 Colorado 2025 winner.

Away from work, you'll find Peter white-water rafting near Buena Vista with his family, mentoring emerging restaurant groups, and pursuing his vision to reinvent suburban casual dining—creating immersive, experiential dining concepts that transport guests beyond their day-to-day.

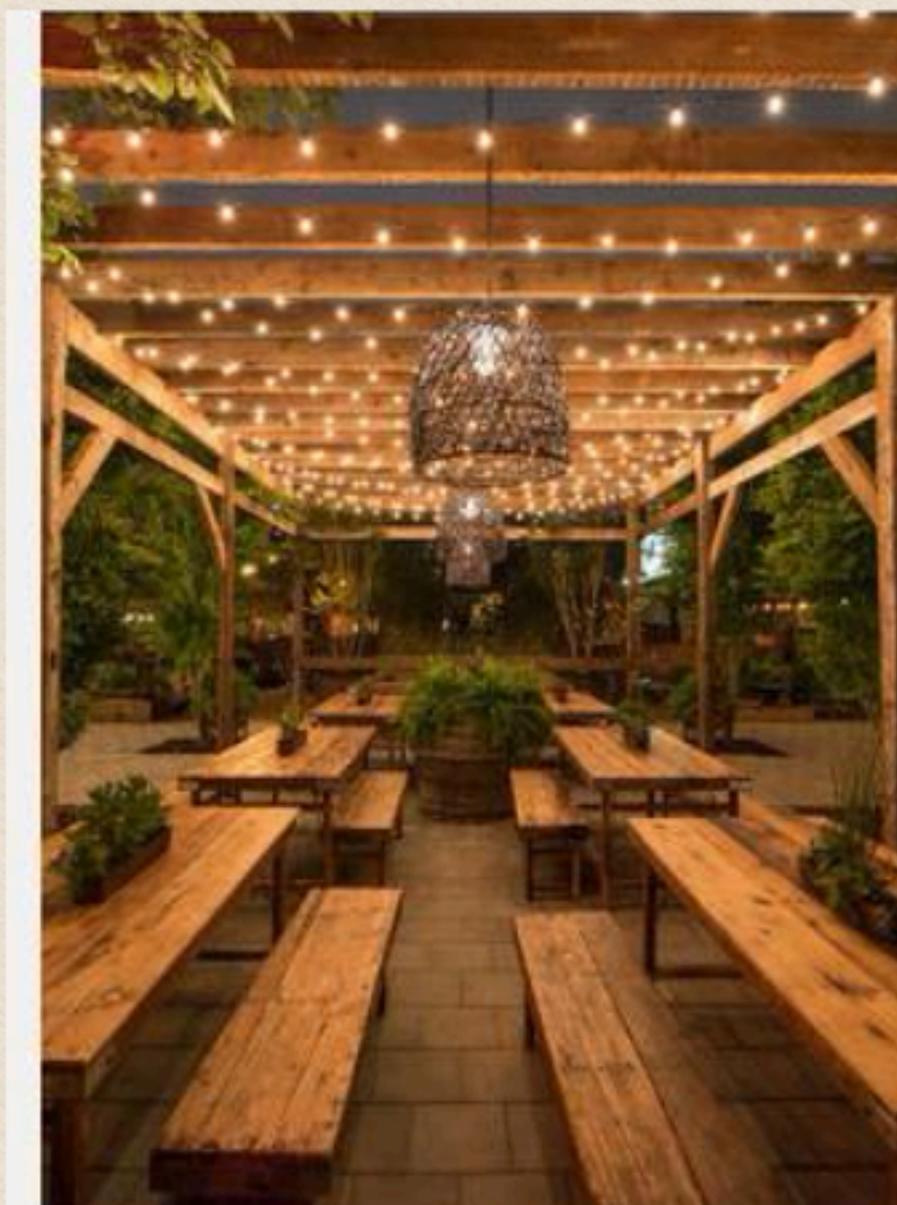

The Tack Room and bridal suites add personal touches, while the outdoor bar and sweeping lawns create the perfect backdrop for cocktail hour against the Front Range. Beyond weddings, the Field House is a flexible event hub hosting concerts, galas, fundraisers, and community activations that bring people together, weaving lasting experiences into Colorado's story.



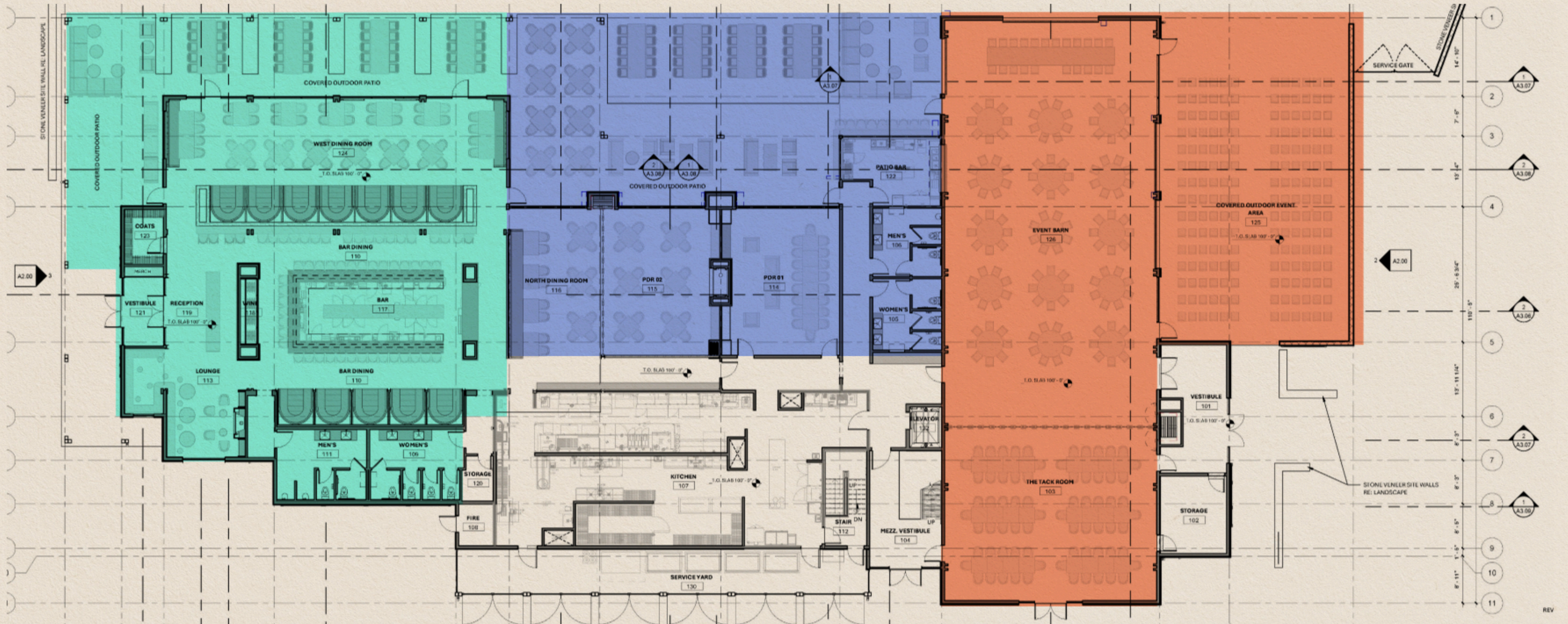

Middle Section (blue highlight)

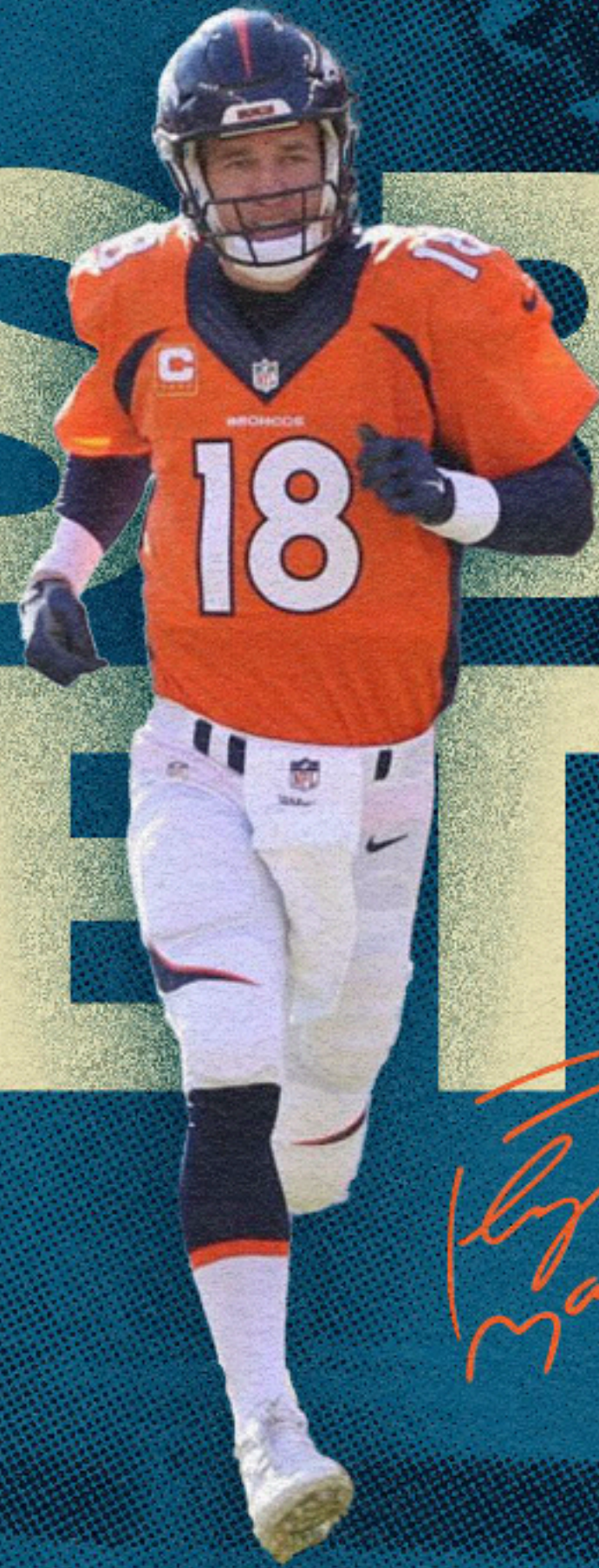
Five flexible private dining spaces designed for gatherings of every size.
