

How Funds were Spent

For the year ended December 31, 2024 a total of approximately \$1.2 M of 3A funds were raised.
 During the year ended December 31, 2024 a total of approximately \$8.8M was spent. A detail breakdown can be found in the 3A Capital Improvement Fund Spending by Misric Category and Program Details for the year ended

· As of December 31, 2024, the 3A fund has approximately \$21.7M of funds available for future projects

PURPOSE

- November 2021 3A Ballot Measure: created a dedicated \$0.0075 sales tax increase to address backlogged capital improvement projects.
- Capital Improvement Sales Tax Board: Created by City Council in July 2022 to fulfill
 requirement that the city report annually the expenditures and progress of the 3A Capital
 Improvement Sales Tax.
- Annual Report: Per the board charter and action plan, city staff is required to prepare a report by March 31st for board review.



SALES TAX BOARD MEETINGS

- Staff prepared the 3A Sales Tax Fund 2024 Report by March 31st
- Board reviewed the report at the April 30th and May 29th
 Board meetings
- Staff provided follow up information as requested by the board
- Board prepared memo for presentation to City Council
