

Local Laws that are tougher than the Colorado Clean Indoor Air Act

The Colorado Clean Indoor Air Act of 2006 does not include all indoor and outdoor work and public places. Local communities have passed laws that provide greater protection from secondhand tobacco smoke and electronic cigarette aerosols. Updated June 2015.

Smoking prohibited in the outdoor areas of restaurants and bars.

- Arvada
- Boulder
- Eagle County
- Edgewater
- Firestone

- *Coors Field and Sports Authority Field have smoke-free outdoor seating*

Smoking prohibited in certain outdoor areas:

- Arvada (*city-owned parks, trails, recreation areas*)
- Avon (*recreation areas, lift and service lines*)
- Breckenridge (*city-owned parks, open spaces, sporting fields and facilities, service and lift lines, multi-use paths*)
- Boulder (*downtown mall and business area, parks, trails, transit waiting areas, event tents, multiuse paths*)
- Brighton (*within 100' of organized sporting events held at public parks/sports complexes*)
- Broomfield (*service lines*)
- Carbondale (*skate parks*)
- Commerce City (*parks and trails*)
- Coors Field and Sports Authority (*seating areas*)
- Denver (*certain stadium areas, pools, zoos, hospital sidewalks and grounds*)
- Dillon (*amphitheaters*)
- Durango (*bus stops, public transportation waiting areas, city-owned parks, playgrounds, pavilions, recreational facilities, ball fields, and the Animas River Trail and adjacent greenway*)
- Eagle County (*recreation facilities, service lines, and ski-lift lines*)
- Edgewater (*sporting events, and parks*)
- Fort Collins (*downtown area, outdoor serving areas, bus benches and shelters, city-owned parks and trails, and transit areas*)
- Golden (*playgrounds*)
- Grand junction (*sporting events*)
- Greeley (*public ball fields and pools*)
- Lakewood (*city events, playgrounds, swimming pools, skate parks, athletic fields, picnic shelters, tennis courts and similar locations*)
- Northglenn (*seating aisles, rest rooms, and concession areas of sports facilities*)
- Pueblo (*hospital sidewalks and grounds*)
- San Luis (*arenas, stadiums, amphitheaters*)
- Steamboat Springs (*city-owned stadiums, sporting events, parks, pools, playgrounds*)
- Summit County (*transit waiting areas*)
- Winter Park (*parks, playfields and trails*)
- Timnath (*sporting and recreation areas, tennis courts, swimming pools, and sports fields during organized events*)

Smoking prohibited in all bars and restaurants including any cigar or tobacco bars:

Smoking of electronic cigarettes is prohibited

Smoking prohibited further away or in more entryways

Smoking prohibited in tobacco retail stores (includes tobacco shops and hookah lounges):

- Timnath
