7	A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
8	LITTLETON, COLORADO, APPROVING A NEW URBAN RENEWAL
9	PLAN KNOWN AS THE "NORTH BROADWAY URBAN RENEWAL
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12 13	WHEREAS, an urban renewal plan for the North Broadway Urban Renewal Area has been submitted to the City Council of the City of Littleton for
14	appropriate action, pursuant to Part 1 of Article 25 of Title 31, C.R.S.;
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16	WHEREAS, the North Broadway Urban Renewal Area, which is subject
17	to the North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan, is described in Exhibit A to this
18	Resolution;
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20	WHEREAS, the North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan has previously
21 22	been submitted to the City of Littleton Planning Board for its review and recommendation as to conformity with the general plan for development of the
23	municipality in accordance with C.R.S. § 31-25-107(2);
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25	WHEREAS, the City of Littleton Planning Board has determined that the
26	North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan does conform to the City of Littleton's
27	general plan for development;
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29	WHEREAS, no property in the North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan has
30 31	been included in an urban renewal plan previously submitted to and not approved by the City Council of the City of Littleton within the previous twenty four (24)
32	months;
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34	WHEREAS, notice of the time, place, and purpose of the public hearing
35	to consider the adoption of the North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan was
36	published in the Littleton Independent, a newspaper of general circulation within
37	the City, at least thirty (30) days before the public hearing in conformance with
38 39	C.R.S. § 31-25-107(3);
40	WHEREAS, the City of Littleton has provided written notice of the
40 41	public hearing to consider the adoption of the North Broadway Urban Renewal
42	Plan to all property owners, residents, and business owners within the proposed
43	North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan Area at their last known address in
44	conformance with C.R.S. § 31-25-107(4)(c);
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46	WHEREAS, the Arapahoe County Commissioners have received

47 notification of and copies of the North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan, as well as 48 such additional information as is required by C.R.S. § 31-25-107(3.5); 49 50 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Littleton has considered the North Broadway Conditions Survey prepared by Ricker/Cunningham and the 51 52 proposed North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan; and 53 54 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Littleton has conducted a 55 public hearing and considered the public testimony received. 56 57 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF 58 THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT: 59 60 Blight, as defined by C.R.S. § 31-25-103(2), is present in the North Section 1. Broadway Urban Renewal Plan Area, as documented by the North Broadway Conditions Survey 61 62 prepared by Ricker/Cunningham and based on additional evidence presented at the public 63 hearing. All of the blight factors as set forth in C.R.S. § 31-25-103(2) are present within the 64 Urban Renewal Plan Area. 65 66 Section 2. The North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan Area is a blighted area 67 and is appropriate for an urban renewal project pursuant to Part 1 of Article 25 of Title 31, 68 C.R.S. 69 70 Based on the evidence presented at the public hearing, the City Section 3. 71 Council of the City of Littleton hereby further finds and determines that: 72 73 To the extent applicable, there exist feasible methods for the relocation of (a) 74 individuals, families, and business concerns in accommodations or areas suitable for their 75 relocation. 76 The City Council has taken reasonable efforts to provide written notice of (b) 77 the public hearing to all property owners, residents and owners of business concerns in the 78 proposed urban renewal area at their last known address of record at least thirty days prior to the 79 hearing. Such notice contained the information required by C.R.S. § 31-25-107(3). 80 81 No more than 120 days have passed since the commencement of the first (c) 82 public hearing of the North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan. 83 84 The North Broadway Renewal Plan does not contain property that was (d) included in a previously submitted urban renewal plan that the City Council failed to approve. 85 86 87 The North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan conforms to the general plan of (e) the City of Littleton as a whole. 88 89 90 The North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan will afford maximum (f) 91 opportunity, consistent with the sound needs of the City of Littleton as a whole, for the rehabilitation or redevelopment of the urban renewal area by private enterprise. 92

94 (g) The Littleton Invests for Tomorrow Urban Renewal Authority or the City 95 of Littleton will adequately finance any additional county infrastructure and services required to 96 serve development in the urban renewal area during the applicable tax increment financing 97 period as set forth in C.R.S. § 31-25-107(9)(a)(II).

99 The principal purpose for the adoption of the North Broadway Urban (h) 100 Renewal Plan is to facilitate redevelopment in order to eliminate or prevent the spread of 101 physically blighted areas.

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(i) The boundaries of the North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan Area have been drawn as narrowly as feasible to accomplish the planning and development objectives for 105 the North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan.

107 The North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan does not consist in its entirety (j) 108 of open land. 109

110 (k) The acquisition, clearance, rehabilitation, conservation, development or 111 redevelopment or a combination thereof of the North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan, pursuant 112 to the North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan, is necessary and in the best interests of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Littleton. 113

114 Section 4. Based on the above findings, the City Council approves the North 115 Broadway Urban Renewal Plan dated December 2, 2014. From and after the date of adoption of 116 117 this Resolution, the real property described within the North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan shall, for all purposes, be subject to the provisions of the North Broadway Urban Renewal Plan. 118 119
