**A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING BOARD OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, RECOMMENDING AMENDING CITY CODE SECTIONS 10-3-2 AND 10-8-2 ALLOWING TATTOO PARLORS AND BODY ARTS STUDIOS IN THE COMMUNITY BUSINESS DISTRICT (B-2), GENERAL BUSINESS DISTRICT (B-3) AND CENTRAL AREA MULTIPLE USE DISTRICT (CA) SUBJECT TO CONDITIONAL USE APPROVAL AND AMENDED WITH ALL SIGNAGE TO COMPLY WITH SECTION 4-3-2-5 OF THE CODE.**

**WHEREAS**, the planning board of the City of Littleton, Colorado, held a public hearing at its regular meetings of December 8, 2014 and January 26, 2015, to consider the proposed ordinance that will allow tattoo parlors and body arts studios in the B-2, B-3 and CA districts after approval of a conditional use and subject to limitations, more specifically described in the ordinance attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made part hereof by this reference;

**WHEREAS**, the planning board considered evidence and testimony concerning the proposed amendments to the Littleton City Code at said public hearings; and

**WHEREAS**, the planning board finds that the proposed amendments are in the best interest of the city and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of its inhabitants;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING BOARD OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

**Section 1:** With the addition of the requirement, "All signage to comply with Section 4-3-2-5 of this code," the planning board does hereby recommend approval to the city council of the proposed amendments allowing tattoo parlors and body arts studios in the B-2, B-3 and CA districts after approval of a conditional use and subject to limitations, more specifically described in the ordinance attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
