Sec. 104. Provision for Services.

3 The Council shall provide by ordinance fire and police and health services for the 4 preservation of the rights of persons and for the preservation of public and private 5 property, health, peace and safety. These functions shall include the enforcement 6 of the laws of the State and the ordinances of the City, the prevention of crime 7 and the apprehension of criminals. In a separate ordinance, the Council shall, for 8 so long as it deems necessary, provide for the formation and operation of a 9 volunteer fire department. Such ordinance shall clearly define the authorities, duties and responsibilities of the department; provided however, that such 10 ordinance shall not in any manner restrict the authority of the City Manager over 11 12 any paid employees or property of the City.

14 **Section 6:** Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of 15 this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of 16 the remaining sections of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have 17 passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof, 18 irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases 19 may be declared invalid.
