## BRIEF HISTORY OF CITY DITCH

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## CITY DITCH

- 26 mile irrigation canal
- Capitol Hydraulic Company constructed the ditch
- Began in 1861 in a location about 4 miles upstream
- Construction restarted in 1864 and was completed in 1867






## CITY DITCH

- Richard Little hired to survey the ditch
  - Resurveying found that the original start of the ditch was ineffective
- City Ditch allowed for greater development in the region
- Little opened the Rough and Ready Mill and founded Littleton
  - The mill utilized the abandoned 1861 ditch









## SLAUGHTERHOUSE GULCH FLUME

- Flumes were used to "bridge"
  features like gulches or side streams
- Originally constructed from wood
- Current steel structure was likely built in the 1940s
- Located in Slaughterhouse Gulch
  Park north of Powers Ave and
  North School
