| 19       | may be an imminent need to procure necessary supplies and services such that it may be                         |
| 20       | impossible to immediately convene a meeting of city council to authorize procurement of such                   |

| 23       | WHEREAS, city council has determined that, because of this need to expedite                                    |
| 24       | procurement during an emergency, it is necessary and prudent to proactively grant this authority               |

| 28       | and welfare of the residents of the City of Littleton, in cases of emergencies where there is                  |
