

**THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
FOR MANAGEMENT, OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE
OF THE SOUTH PLATTE RESERVOIR SITE**

This Third Amendment to Intergovernmental Agreement for Management, Operations and Maintenance of the South Platte Reservoir Site (“Third Amendment”) is entered into to be effective as of ____ day of _____, 2024.

WHEREAS, the City of Littleton (“City”), South Suburban Park and Recreation District (“SSPRD”), and Centennial Water and Sanitation District (“District”) entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement for Management, Operations and Maintenance of the South Platte Reservoir Site dated June 6, 2006 (“Original IGA”), as amended by letter dated September 1, 2011 (“First Amendment”) and Second Amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement for Management, Operations and Maintenance of the South Platte Reservoir Site dated June 4, 2019 (“Second Amendment”), which provides that no water-based recreation activities are allowed on the South Platte Reservoir; and to install rest benches along the current walking trail provided they do not interfere in dam safety or management.

WHEREAS, the Original IGA, First Amendment and Second Amendment are herein collectively referred to as the “Intergovernmental Agreement”; and

WHEREAS, SSPRD is requesting permission to construct and maintain, at its sole expense, a walking path along the west perimeter of the South Platte Reservoir, outside of the existing security fence, in order to provide a safe alternative for pedestrians who must walk on along the South Platte Reservoir Access Road. The general location of the walking path is depicted on the attached *Exhibit A*, attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. **Approval of Request.** The District has reviewed the requests and will allow the construction and operation of the walking path as described on *Exhibit A*.
2. **Notification.** SSPRD will notify the District 72 hours in advance of any construction activities for the installation of the walking path. Notification shall be given to:

3. **Effect of Amendment.** The Intergovernmental Agreement, as amended by this Third Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect.



Amendment 3, Exhibit A

Currently pedestrians enter the South Platte Reservoir area via the gate near Platte Canyon Road, and walk or bike in the roadway, to the first parking lot before having the option to use a trail along the reservoir perimeter.

To get more pedestrians off the roadway, and particularly off the blind corner, South Suburban Parks and Recreation would like to install via our labor and expense, a hardened walking trail in places where space and drainage allow, as shown on the map below. Red arrows indicate the primary location. Lighter color arrows may be added if space and drainage allow.



Construction would consist of scraping or grubbing the upper layer of existing vegetation, compacting a base, and installing compacted crusher fines in a crowned fashion to shed water. The trail would remain on the outside of any security fencing and away from water or service roads. 6" diameter drainage pipes may be needed under the trail if storm drainage requires, and installation may include directional signage for pedestrians, or caution signs for drivers for sections where trail cannot be built.
