**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LITTLETON, COLORADO, APPROVING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF
MAIN STREET TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC, OR OTHER MUNICIPALLY
OWNED THOROUGHFARES, AND DESIGNATING THEM EXTENDED
SIDEWALK SPACE**

WHEREAS, in response to COVID-19 and limitations placed on businesses regarding social distancing and seating or patronage limitations; and

WHEREAS, the city would like to provide city businesses in the historic downtown area an opportunity to expand their existing premises in a controlled environment by allowing for outdoor seating within the city's right-of-way under certain conditions and declaring that to be sidewalk space; and

WHEREAS, the city desires promotion of a planned and orderly outdoor public seating area as a means of encouraging patronage of businesses in the downtown historic district into this sidewalk area; and

WHEREAS, the temporary closure of Main Street to vehicular traffic or other municipally owned thoroughfare during specifically designated days and times will allow said business to legally extend their businesses boundaries.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

The Littleton City Council does hereby approve the temporary and measured closure of Main Street to vehicular traffic, or other municipally owned thoroughfare, for use by those businesses on said thoroughfare to use as extended sidewalk space.
