8 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
9 COLORADO, APPROVING A FIVE-YEAR AGREEMENT
10 WITH TYLER TECHNOLOGIES FOR A MUNICIPAL
11 COURT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

13 WHEREAS, the current court management system is no longer supported by the
14 vendor, is on an unsupported operating system that cannot be upgraded and poses a security risk
15 for the city, and is significantly impacting productivity; and

16
17 WHEREAS, an updated court management system will improve customer
18 service by improving processing time and providing new/more automated tools; and

19
20 WHEREAS, an updated court management system will improve performance for
21 the courts and increase the capacity for process improvement; and

22
23 WHEREAS, pursuing a five-year term represents a significant cost savings; and

24
25 WHEREAS, the 2020 cost will be lower than currently budgeted; and

26
27 WHEREAS, the cost for future years is anticipated to be offset by process
28 improvements and the e-ticketing surcharge increase.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
31 THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

33 **Section 1:** Council approves the five-year term for the court software contract
34 with Tyler Tech.

37 **Section 2:** Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or
38 phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the
39 validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it
40 would have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or
41 phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences,
42 clauses or phrases may be declared invalid.

44 **Section 3:** Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in
45 conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the
46 repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.
