7 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
8 LITTLETON, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING AN
9 INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH MILE HIGH FLOOD
10 DISTRICT REGARDING FINAL DESIGN, RIGHT OF WAY
11 ACQUISITION, AND CONSTRUCTION OF DRAINAGE AND FLOOD
12 CONTROL IMPROVEMENTS FOR JACKASS GULCH AT HIGHLINE
13 CANAL

16 WHEREAS, the Council may, by resolution, enter into contracts with other
17 government bodies to furnish or receive governmental services, to make or pay for charges for
18 such services and to enter into cooperative or joint activities with other government bodies; and
19

20 WHEREAS, the City of Littleton desires to enter into an agreement with Mile
21 High Flood District to contribute funds to the design and construction of improvements at
22 Jackass Gulch from Highline Canal to Jamison Way, with expected amendments to encumber
23 future funds; and

25 WHEREAS, the City’s 2020 share of the costs of the project, as set forth in the
26 Agreement, shall be a contribution of \$175,000 towards design and construction of the
27 improvements, \$97,110 of which is from an Arapahoe County Open Space planning grant.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
30 THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

32 The Agreement Regarding Final Design, Right-of-Way Acquisition, and
33 Construction of Drainage and Flood Control Improvements for Jackass Gulch at
34 Highline Canal, City of Littleton, Agreement No. 20-08.21 is hereby approved.
