

PROJECT BENEFITS



Multimodal safety and accessibility elements at the southern end of the city

- Increased accessibility to C-470 Trail
- Increased accessibility to High Line Canal Trail
- Connection to bike lanes and sidewalks in Southpark
- Protected intersection at Southpark Lane
- Filling sidewalk/trail gaps along County Line Road



PROJECT BACKGROUND

- David Evans & Associates (DEA) selected to design multimodal improvements to provide better access to C-470 and High Line Canal Trails and areas near Broadway and County Line Road
- Staff originally authorized DEA to perform preliminary design in 2023.
- This amendment is to authorize DEA to finish final design and produce bid level documents for these improvements
- Design: Fall 2023 – Spring 2025
- Construction: Fall 2025 – Summer 2026



CONTRACT DETAILS

- Preliminary Design Costs = \$361,219
- Final Design Costs = \$246,700
- Total Contract Amount = \$607,919

- Staff recommends authorizing a contract amendment with David Evans & Associates in the amount of \$246,700
