9                                   **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,**  
10                                   **COLORADO, AUTHORIZING A TWO-YEAR FARM**  
11                                   **LEASE AGREEMENT WITH KENT BEICHLE FOR THE**  
12                                   **SOUTH PLATTE WATER RENEWAL PARTNERS**

14                                   **WHEREAS**, the Cities of Littleton and Englewood jointly own property near  
15 Bennett, Colorado, which is used for the South Platte Water Renewal Partners (SPWRP)  
16 Biosolids Management Program (Program).

18                                   **WHEREAS**, the Program uses dryland farm property for long-term applications  
19 of domestic wastewater biosolids generated by the SPWRP; and

21                                   **WHEREAS**, Kent Beichle desires to continue participation in the Program by  
22 extending the farm lease agreement through December 31, 2020.

24                                   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF**  
25 **THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

27                                   **Section 1:** The City Council of the City of Littleton hereby authorizes the Farm  
28 Lease between Kent Beichle and the Cities of Littleton and Englewood, attached hereto as  
29 Exhibit A.

31                                   **Section 2:** Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or  
32 phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the  
33 validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it  
34 would have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or  
35 phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences,  
36 clauses or phrases may be declared invalid.

38                                   **Section 3:** Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in  
39 conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the  
40 repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.

42                                   INTRODUCED AS A BILL at a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council

44 of the City of Littleton on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2019, passed on first reading by a vote of 7  
45 FOR and 0 AGAINST; and ordered published by posting at Littleton Center, Bemis Library, the

Municipal Courthouse and on the City of Littleton Website.
