**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
COLORADO, AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LITTLETON AND THE COUNTY
OF ARAPAHOE REGARDING A FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION FOR
RESURFACING OF KEN CARYL AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS the council may, by resolution, enter into contracts with other governmental bodies to furnish or receive government services, to make or pay charges for such services, or enter into cooperative or other joint activities with other governmental bodies; and

WHEREAS the City of Littleton received federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) and state Funding Advancements for Surface Transportation and Economic Recovery Act of 2009 (FASTER) funds from the Colorado Department of Transportation ("CDOT") to design and implement infrastructure improvements at the following locations: i) the intersection of South Platte Canyon Road (SH 75)/South Lowell Boulevard and West Bowles Avenue; and ii) the intersection of South Platte Canyon Road (SH 75) and West Mineral Avenue. The infrastructure improvements are to enhance pedestrian and bicycle safety, to resolve traffic conflicts, to improve bus stop access, and to upgrade signal equipment (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS Arapahoe County desires to resurface Ken Caryl Avenue ("Additional Improvements"), which is outside the scope of the work for the Project; and

WHEREAS for purposes of mutual cost savings and construction efficiencies, Littleton has agreed to construct the Additional Improvements while implementing infrastructure improvements for the Project; and

WHEREAS Arapahoe County and the City of Littleton desire to enter into an agreement, in which Arapahoe County will financially contribute to the Project, and to further define the Parties role in relation to the Project, as further set forth in Exhibit "A;"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth in fully.

Section 2. The Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Littleton and Arapahoe County Regarding a Financial Contribution for Resurfacing of Ken Caryl Avenue Improvements is hereby approved, in substantially the same form as Exhibit "A" and the mayor is hereby authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreement.
