 SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT By Officer J. DIMITRIC
 On 05/05/2017 at approximately 0156 hours, I responded with Officer DIMOCK to The Toad Tavern (5302 S. Federal Cir) on a report of a disturbance. I was advised that a male had punched a female. The male suspect was described as wearing black shorts.
 When I arrived on scene, Sgt. CARLSON was ordering three males to sit on the ground outside the bar, one of which was wearing black shorts. The male was later identified via AR DL (#938752791), as Joel CLINE (DOB [REDACTED]). The other two males were identified as the bar manager and another bar patron.
 I observed that both of CLINE's knees were bloody and he had a hard time formulating sentences as he slurred his speech significantly. CLINE was yelling at Sgt. CARLSON, "Fuck you" when Sgt. CARLSON told him to remain seated as he tried standing up multiple times.
 Additional officers (GUZMAN, JONES, MANNERINGS) arrived on scene and documented the front glass door of the bar, which was off its hinges, and a podium inside the bar that was tipped onto its front. The female who had been punched was also inside speaking with Officer MANNERINGS.
 I stood outside with Officer DIMOCK and Sgt. CARLSON as they spoke to CLINE, who was still seated on a curb. CLINE was continuously cursing at Officer DIMOCK and Sgt. CARLSON and demanded to stand. Officer DIMOCK and Sgt. CARLSON repeatedly told CLINE that he was to remain seated due to his agitated behavior however, CLINE kept trying to get up. CLINE then attempted to stand up again after being told to sit down by Officer DIMOCK. Officer DIMOCK placed his hand on CLINE's shoulder ordering him to sit down and that he could not stand. CLINE slapped Officer DIMOCK's hand off of his shoulder and yelled, "Don't you fucking touch me!" CLINE then tried to stand up again and Officer DIMOCK and Sgt. CARLSON pushed CLINE onto his side, then onto his stomach and placed him into handcuffs to better control CLINE. CLINE then went limp and appeared to be unconscious but breathing heavily. Sgt. CARLSON called for LFR to respond to the scene. Once Sgt. CARLSON called for LFR, CLINE opened his eyes and began yelling profanities at Sgt. CARLSON and Officer DIMOCK. While in handcuffs and seated with his back up against Officer DIMOCK's legs, CLINE continued to thrash his body and kick at Sgt. CARLSON. Corporal MARTENS then arrived on scene and applied a RIPP restraint to CLINE's legs to prevent him from kicking officers. I then walked into the bar with Officer DIMOCK after CLINE was secured. I later learned that CLINE had kicked Corporal MARTENS in the leg after being placed into the RIPP restraint causing him pain to his leg.
 I entered the bar to observe Officer DIMOCK as he handled the investigation. Officer DIMOCK was interviewing multiple people inside the bar and obtaining written statements. When LFR arrived on scene, I went back out to where CLINE was still seated on the ground. CLINE was yelling at Corporal MARTENS and Officer GUZMAN, "I hope you die!" He also repeated multiple times to all officers outside, "Fuck you!" I stood nearby, uninvolved in the situation, and CLINE looked over at me and he said to me, "You're a fuck neck. I hope you die." LFR advised that if they transported CLINE to Littleton Adventist Hospital that CLINE would have to come out of handcuffs. It was determined that CLINE

would not be cooperative if he was un-handcuffed and was therefore going to be transported by Police in a patrol vehicle. While Officer JONES was attempting to walk CLINE into his patrol vehicle, CLINE refused to walk and made his body limp resulting in three officers having to carry CLINE to Officer JONES' patrol vehicle. CLINE then refused to get into the vehicle and began screaming loudly. Corporal MARTENS loosened the RIPP restraint so CLINE could have enough room to lift his leg and step up into the vehicle, but CLINE was still not cooperating. CLINE had to be lifted up into the vehicle by Officer JONES.

After CLINE was placed into the vehicle, I went back into the bar to observe Officer DIMOCK. Sgt. CARLSON was also walking about the bar obtaining statements from the patrons inside the bar. At approximately 0245 hours, Officer DIMOCK began to collect finished written statements. Around that time, Sgt. CARLSON exited the bar's bathroom and advised me that there was a male hiding in the bathroom. After advising me of the male, Sgt. CARLSON went back into the bathroom and asked the male, later identified as Lee SIMONES (DOB [REDACTED]), to come out of the bathroom. The above time was substantiated with the NCIC/CCIC clearance of SIMONES via LPD Dispatch by Sgt. CARLSON.

Sgt. CARLSON asked SIMONES why he was in the bathroom for the entire duration of Police's presence. SIMONES stated that he was using his phone while in the bathroom because the music inside the bar was too loud. There was no music playing inside the bar at any time during our investigation.

Sgt. CARLSON advised me that two female witnesses had previously told him that they observed another male in the bar when CLINE became belligerent with everyone. They also advised Sgt. CARLSON that the male had gone out into the parking lot after CLINE and proceeded to physically fight CLINE. The two females told Sgt. CALSON that the unidentified male then disappeared before Police arrived. The two females were identified as, Ashley SELHEIM-PHILPOTT (DOB [REDACTED]) and Kimmie LARSON (DOB [REDACTED]).

SELHEIM-PHILPOTT and LARSON were still seated at the bar awaiting any further needed information by Officers. I spoke to both females and asked them if the male (SIMONES), who was currently speaking with Sgt. CARLSON, was the male they observed fighting in the parking lot with CLINE. Both SELHEIM-PHILPOTT and LARSON stated, "Yes." Both females expressed to me that they were surprised to see SIMONES when I pointed SIMONES out to them because they had no idea where he went.

I had no further involvement with this investigation.

Supplemental Report: Officer Anthony Guzman 2015-10

On May 5, 2017 at approximately 0156 hours I responded to The Toad Tavern, 5302 S. Federal Cir. in reference to a disturbance. Littleton Police Dispatch advised a male had punched a female and was outside the bar.

Upon arrival, Sergeant S. Carlson was speaking with three males that were sitting on the ground. One of the males was later identified as Joel Cline (DOB [REDACTED]). Joel was being verbally aggressive with Sergeant Carlson and was being uncooperative.

I then went inside of the bar to locate witnesses and hand out written statements. While I was inside, I observed

Officer B. Dimock and Sgt. Carlson pushing Cline to the ground. As they were pushing Cline to the ground, he continued to resist and pull away. I walked back outside and Officer Dimock placed Cline into handcuffs. Cline then appeared to be unconscious and Littleton Fire was advised to respond to the scene.

While in handcuffs, Cline regained consciousness and continued to be physically combative. Cline continuously kicked his feet and attempted to stand up. Corporal P. Martens restrained Cline's feet with a RIPP restraint. Cline then kicked Corporal Martens with both of his legs. I then grabbed Cline's arms and pushed him to the ground. When I pushed Cline to the ground, I gave loud verbal commands to stop resisting.

Littleton Fire arrived on scene and gave Cline medical attention. Cline continued to be physically aggressive and would not cooperate with Fire personnel. Officer J. Jones and I assisted Cline to his feet and walked him to Officer Jones' patrol vehicle. Officer Jones secured Cline in the back of his patrol vehicle and transported him to the Littleton Adventist Hospital. Corporal Martens and I also responded to the hospital.

At the Hospital, medical staff brought a bed to the patrol vehicle to place Cline on. When Cline was taken out of the vehicle, he was still physically combative by swinging his shoulders and attempting to kick his legs. Cline then turned to Corporal Martens and appeared as if he was going to spit on Corporal Martens. Concerned Cline was going to spit on Corporal Martens, I pushed him onto the medical bed and Hospital staff took Cline into the hospital where he was placed in a room.

In the room, Cline was still very physically aggressive and had to be secured to the hospital bed using a four point restraint. Cline made numerous statements including, "I'm going to kill you in four years", "You're a pussy" and "You're going to die". Due to Cline's aggressiveness, hospital staff sedated Cline. After Cline was sedated, I left the hospital.

Supplemental Report by Corporal Paul Martens:

On May 5, 2017, at approximately 0156 hours, I was dispatched to The Toad Tavern at 5302 South Federal Circle, in regards to a physical disturbance.

Upon arrival I observed officers trying to physically restrain Joel Cline, DOB [REDACTED]. I assisted with putting a "RIPP Restraint" on Cline's legs. Once restrained Cline was sat up and was being supported by Officer Guzman.

While being supported by Officer Guzman, Cline flipped over on his side and kicked me in my right calf with both feet causing me pain.

Cline was making statements to me like "I hope you die," "fucking faggot," "Do you have kids? I do, I hope you die," and "you're all going to die." I heard Cline call Officer Dimtric a "fuck neck" and "Virginia."

Cline continued to be verbally abusive while on scene. Cline resisted as he was put in the rear of Officer Jones' patrol vehicle and refused to get in. Officer Jones transported Cline to Littleton Hospital.

While at the hospital Cline continued to be verbally abusive. He said "you're going to die" and "I hope you die" several times. Cline was physically resistive and started kicking his legs so he had to be physically restrained to the bed.

Cline would become apologetic and ask to talk and then would become agitated and start to struggle in his restraints.

As I photographed Cline's injuries he would start to move so I could not photograph them. I had to hold Cline's right hand down to photograph it. I asked Cline to cooperate and he said "fuck you, I hope you die."

Cline made the statement "I'm going to kill you in 3 years" several times. Cline told Sergeant Carlson "I'm going to kill you in four years." I asked Cline why he said that and he said "It's going to take that long to track down all of his family."

Cline continued to be verbally abusive to staff and tried to tip his bed over several times. He had to be sedated by staff. Cline was seen by Doctor Lina Tran.

Cline took his medical monitoring devices and oxygen off several times and stated "don't fucking touch me, I'll kill you." Cline called staff members names like "faggot" several times.

Cline spit on Security Sergeant Sean Best when he went in to the room to check on him. Best completed a written statement, which I gave to Officer Dimock.

When I left the hospital, Cline was sedated and sleeping.

On 05-05-2017 at approximately 0155 hours, I was dispatched to 5302 S. Federal Cir. on a possible disturbance. Upon arrival I assisted with taking pictures of the scene. I used Officer Dimock's work cellular phone to take the pictures. After taking the pictures, I gave Officer Dimock his phone back so that the pictures could be added to the case.

I then assisted with putting the suspect, later identified as Joel Cline (DOB [REDACTED]), in my patrol car so that he could be transported to Littleton Hospital. Joel would not cooperate and kept refusing to get in my patrol car. When I started lifting Joel into the patrol car, he started complaining about his wrists hurting. I was lifting Joel by his shoulders with my hands and lifting his left knee with my left knee. I stopped trying to put Joel in the vehicle when he started complaining about his wrists hurting. Joel then got in the patrol car and I transported him to Littleton Hospital.

At the Hospital, Joel was still not cooperating and had to be placed in four point restraints. When Joel was placed in the restraints, he started complaining about his wrists again. Because Joel was complaining about his wrists, I had the Doctor look at them. When the Doctor looked at his wrists, he said that he was fine and did not want to be looked at. The suspect would not tell the Doctor, or I, what wrist was hurting.

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT BY SGT. S. CARLSON:

On 050517, at approximately 0156 hours, I, Sgt. S. CARLSON responded to The Toad Tavern, 5302 S. Federal Circle, Littleton, Arapahoe, Colorado on a physical disturbance in the parking lot. Dispatch advised that the suspect in the disturbance was a white male wearing black shorts.

I arrived on scene and observed three (3) males directly in front of the bar arguing with each other and one of the males was being "held" back by another. I immediately activated my overhead emergency equipment and exited my vehicle giving all three of the males loud verbal commands to sit on the ground. The male in the black shorts, later identified as Joel CLINE {DOB [REDACTED]}, refused to sit down and turned to walk away.

I continued to yell loud verbal commands at CLINE, who then turned around and complained that he should not be the only one to sit down. I again ordered the other two (2) males to be seated and they both immediately complied.

Officer DIMOCK began interviewing CLINE who was seated on the curb and was not being detained nor handcuffed. CLINE refused to answer any of Officer DIMOCK's questions, simply remaining silent or telling us to "Fuck off." I attempted to use CIT techniques on CLINE and he began to deescalate and started to answer questions. CLINE stated that the situation was his fault and he admitted to drinking. I asked CLINE what time he got to the bar and he stated, "It doesn't matter, I am leaving."

CLINE began to stand up, but was visibly intoxicated and was staggering around as he stood. Officer DIMOCK ordered CLINE to sit back down multiple times and each time the duration of CLINE remained seated decreased. Officer DIMOCK placed his hand on CLINE's shoulder and CLINE shouted, "Don't fucking touch me." CLINE immediately tried to stand and was pushed back to the curb by Officer DIMOCK. CLINE tried to stand again and both DIMOCK and I forced CLINE to his side and then onto his stomach, as to place him into handcuffs. CLINE began to wheeze heavily as he was breathing and closed his eyes. CLINE then went limp and laid on the concrete on his side, as Officer DIMOCK supported CLINE's head. I immediately requested Littleton Fire Rescue respond to check on CLINE's condition.

While waiting for LFR to respond, I contacted two (2) females who were standing outside the bar smoking. Both females, later identified as Kimberly LARSON {DOB [REDACTED]} and Ashley SELHEIM-PHILPOTT {DOB [REDACTED]}, stated they witnessed the majority of the incident both inside and outside the bar and were willing to do written statements. Once done smoking their cigarettes, I observed both females enter the bar and begin to complete

the statements. Both LARSON and SELHEIM-PHILPOTT stated that they had observed another male leave the bar during the disturbance and then physically fight with CLINE in the parking lot.

While inside the bar, I directed Officer DIMOCK and Officer MANNERINGS through the investigation and assisted as needed. During this time period, nobody entered or exited the establishment that had not already been identified and interviewed.

At approximately 0240 hours, I asked the bar manager if I could use the restroom and as I entered I observed a pair of men's shoes in the stall. I then heard a male making grunting noises and then heard the toilet paper roll move. I returned to the bar and verified all the involved parties were still in contact with Officers, and that no one else should be in the bar and especially hiding in the bathroom. I advised Officer DIMITRIC of the additional male in the bathroom and she moved towards the restrooms to provide cover. Before entering the men's room again, I contacted one of the females, I initially thought was an employee, identified as Judith TAYLOR {DOB ██████████}, TAYLOR stated that no one should be in the bathroom. TAYLOR than stated something to the affect of, that's just another guy who was here, he didn't see anything.

I entered the men's room and found a male, later identified as Lee Lincoln SIMONES {DOB ██████████}, standing casually near the sinks talking on his cellular phone. I asked SIMONES what he was doing and he stated, "Just using the bathroom." I asked why he was in the bathroom for so long and he stated, "I was on the phone with a good friend from California." SIMONES was wearing a white shirt and baggy green hiking pants. On SIMONES shirt I observed a small red/brown spot smaller than a dime, that based on my training and experience appeared to be blood. I also observed a matching spot on SIMONES' pant leg. I asked SIMONES to show me his hand and he did. I observed that SIMONES hands looked to have been skinned up, but not bloody. SIMONES denied being involved in the physical disturbance and was just using the bathroom. SIMONES was visibly intoxicated, having bloodshot watery eyes, slurred speech and the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. After locating SIMONES in the bathroom, I immediately recognized him as a frequent bar patron from around the city, where he has been very intoxicated in past encounters.

I had SIMONES exit the men's room and have a seat at a low-top table in the bar area. I then asked Officer DIMITRIC to ask LARSON and SELHEIM-PHILPOTT, who were still seated at the bar, to attempt to identify SIMONES. Both LARSON and SELHEIM-PHILPOTT positively identified SIMONES as the other male involved in the physical fight in the parking lot. Both LARSON and SELHEIM-PHILPOTT stated they witnessed SIMONES throwing punches at CLINE, before police arrived.

I then asked SIMONES to tell me the truth as to what occurred and he stated that his girlfriend BURGESS had been punched in the face by CLINE. SIMONES then stated, "What was I supposed to do, he punched my girlfriend." SIMONES then stated that he went outside after CLINE and only "forced him onto the ground." I asked SIMONES to confirm what he meant by his statement and he said, I didn't do anything but push the guy down to stop the fight. SIMONES denied striking CLINE, even after I explained that there were two independent witnesses.

Officer DIMOCK continued the investigation with SIMONES at that point. After DIMOCK issued the summons to SIMONES, he walked past me being belligerent. SIMONES said something to the effect of, thanks a lot, you just cost me my job. I have XX (mumble) years with the City of Denver.

SIMONES was released on a summons and left the scene.

I then responded to Littleton Adventist Hospital to check on the status of CLINE. Upon arrival, I located CLINE and Officers in a back emergency department room, where CLINE was restrained to the bed, using soft arm and leg restraints. CLINE was still very combative, thrashing around violently almost flipping over his hospital bed. Immediately after CLINE observed me enter his line of sight, he pointed at me and stated, "I'm going to fucking kill you in four years." CLINE was asked why four years and he stated, "That's how long it will take me to find all of your family and loved ones." CLINE was later sedated by Hospital staff for his safety.

On 050517 at approximately 0200hrs I responded to 5302 S Federal Cir., Littleton, Arapahoe, Colorado in response to a disturbance at The Toad Tavern.

As I arrived on scene, I could see Sgt. Carlson and Ofc. Dimmock restraining a male in the parking lot outside of The Toad Tavern. I ran over to assist in restraining the male as Ofc. Dimmock was placing handcuffs on him. The male was resisting arrest and as I held his left leg, I could feel him tense and struggle against me. The male was shouting obscenities at Sgt. Carlson and Ofc. Dimmock. The male said a number of times: "Fuck you," "I'm gonna kill you and your family."

After the male was successfully restrained, I walked over to the entrance of the bar. I could see the front door had been damaged and was knocked off its hinges. There was also a large table overturned and computing equipment on the floor just inside the entrance. I took pictures of the damaged door, table, and computing equipment, and these were booked into LPD evidence. I took pictures of the scene and these were booked into LPD evidence.

I spoke to a female who told me that she had been assaulted by the suspect as she helped escort him out of the bar. She identified herself as Rebecca BURGESS DOB [REDACTED]. BURGESS told me that she had been punched twice, once in the side of the head and once in the face, by the suspect. I could see a small lump, light bruising, and a small lesion on the top of her left forehead, just below the hairline. BURGESS confirmed that this was caused by the suspect as he was being escorted from the bar. BURGESS told me that the lump on head was painful and that her left ear was also hurting from the assault. BURGESS refused medical treatment for her injuries. I photographed her injuries and booked these into LPD evidence.

I next spoke to the bar manager, Timothy FERRY DOB [REDACTED], who told me that the male suspect had been confrontational with customers all night. FERRY said that the suspects aggressive behavior was unprovoked. FERRY

also told me that he thought the male had consumed a few shots and approximately four beers throughout his time at the establishment.

I spoke to a male named Pkoe VONSEGGEN who was sat in the bar and he appeared to be distressed. I asked VONSEGGEN what had happened and he said: "I don't remember." His speech was slurred and he had trouble maintaining his gaze - he was clearly highly intoxicated. His eyes were also red and bloodshot. VONSEGGEN kept asking me what had happened. I kept explaining to him that their had been an altercation in the bar. VONSEGGEN then asked me again: "But what has happened tonight?" in slurred speech. I explained to VONSEGGEN again what had happened but it appeared that VONSEGGEN was unable to comprehend or understand what I was telling him. VONSEGGEN appeared agitated and was struggling to maintain his balance even as he was sat on a chair. His torso was swaying and it was clear that he had consumed a large volume of alcohol. Ofc. Dimmock informed me that VONSEGGEN had taken a PBT with a resulting BAC of 0.327. I managed to speak to VONSEGGEN's father who came to the bar a few moments later to pick up VONSEGGEN. I spoke to BURGESS again who informed me that VONSEGGEN suffered from an unspecified mental illness and she had seen him enter the bar a couple of hours before the incident took place. BURGESS could not say how much VONSEGGEN had had to drink. BURGESS also took a PBT with a resulting BAC of 0.115.

Investigation by Officer Brant Dimock:

I arrived on scene and saw Sergeant Carlson with three males in the parking lot in front of the bar. was loudly demanding why we were detaining him and stated that he had not done anything. I observed that CLINE was bleeding from his left hand causing a trail of blood from his finger tips to the back of his hand.

I asked CLINE what had happened and he stated that he had been assaulted. I asked CLINE, "By who" and he refused to answer. I again asked CLINE what had happened and he stated, "You know what, I did it." I asked CLINE what was it that he had done, and again he refused to answer.

Cline then began to attempt to stand up and was ordered by Sergeant Carlson to stay seated on the ground. CLINE continued to attempt to stand up after being ordered to stay seated approximately four times. CLINE stated, "Fuck you," and began to stand again. I placed my left hand on CLINES's left shoulder and ordered him to remain seated, CLINE slapped my hand away and stated, "Don't you fucking touch me." Sergeant Carlson and I placed CLINE onto his side and then onto his stomach and placed him into custody (handcuffs double locked and checked for tightness) at approximately 0200 hours. Once being placed into handcuffs CLINE's breathing became labored and shallow with a wheezing sound. Sergeant Carlson notified LPD Communications to advise Littleton Fire Rescue and to have them respond with an ambulance to the scene.

I placed CLINE into a seated position and told him just to breath. CLINE again stated, "Fuck you" and began attempting to stand up again in an attempt to charge at other officers.

I placed my hands on both of CLINE's shoulders to keep him seated, CLINE then began kicking his legs. Officer Guzman and Corporal Martens placed a RIPP restraint on CLINE above his knees. Once in the RIPP restraint CLINE kicked Corporal Martens in the leg which caused him pain.

I continued into the bar to speak with other witnesses while Sergeant Carlson and Officer Guzman stayed with CLINE (See supplemental reports).

CLINE was transported to Littleton Hospital for a medical clearance.

Upon entering the bar I observed the front door was completely detached from the door frame.

I contacted BURGESS, Rebecca (DOB [REDACTED]) positively identified via CO DL [REDACTED]. BURGESS stated that she was assisting PERRY, the manager of the bar, in escorting CLINE from the bar. BURGESS stated prior to getting CLINE through the door, CLINE hit her twice with a closed fist to the left side of her head. BURGESS stated that it was painful however she denied medical attention. While on scene I noticed a red mark and the beginnings of a bruise on the left side of BURGESS's head.

I attempted to speak with VONSEGGEN who stated, "I don't even know what happened I'm very drunk." On scene VONSEGGEN submitted to a portable breath test which resulted in a 0.327 BrAC. I was unable to obtain a statement from VONSEGGEN due to his level of intoxication. VONSEGGEN was unable to tell me how much he had drank throughout the night however, he admitted to drinking prior to arriving at the bar and pulled out a .5 littler bottle of Admiral Nelson's Rum from his coat pocket with half its contents missing. VONSEGGEN stated that he had drank both prior to coming to the bar, and had at least two drinks while at the bar.

I spoke to the manager of the bar FERRY who stated that CLINE had arrived at the bar at approximately 2100 hours.

FERRY advised me that CLINE's behavior initially was normal however, "He just seemed weird." FERRY stated that CLINE began to become argumentative with other patrons in the bar and that he had to stop multiple fights between FERRY and other patrons of the bar throughout the night. FERRY failed to notify the police of any of the incidents that had occurred throughout the night.

FERRY stated that he watched CLINE follow VONSEGGEN out of the bar onto the patio while POKE was smoking a cigarette. When VONSEGGEN reentered the bar CLINE followed him and took a seat right next to him at the bar. FERRY stated that CLINE began poking PKOE in the shoulder. CLINE was asked by FERRY to stop however CLINE persisted. VONSEGGEN then asked CLINE to leave the bar. CLINE refused to leave causing FERRY to escort him out of the bar by his shoulders. FERRY stated that CLINE was flailing around attempting to hit him while they were walking towards the door.

Before they got to the door CLINE grabbed the podium near the entrance that holds a computer, and threw it to the ground. FERRY stated that at this time BURGESS attempted to calm CLINE down and help escort him outside. FERRY stated that CLINE then hit BURGESS in the face.

FERRY was able to get CLINE out of the bar and close the door. CLINE then grabbed the door in an attempt to open it. FERRY grabbed the door from the inside in an attempt to keep CLINE outside. CLINE began to violently pulled on the door causing the door to completely detach from the frame.

FERRY exited the bar and CLINE continued to attempt to hit him until the police arrived.

In the bar I spoke to TAYLOR, Judith (DOB [REDACTED]) positively identified via CO DL [REDACTED]. Who witnessed CLINE poking VONSEGGEN in the shoulder. TAYLOR stated that CLINE poked VONSEGGEN in the shoulder until he caused him to cry. TAYLOR stated that CLINE then was escorted out of the bar by her husband FERRY. TAYLOR stated that she saw CLINE strike BURGESS twice in the face and throw the podium on the ground as he was leaving. TAYLOR denied seeing what had occurred outside prior to our arrival.

There were two other witnesses on scene, SELHEIM-PHILPOTT, Ashley (DOB [REDACTED]) positively identified via CO DL [REDACTED], and LARSON, Kimberly (DOB [REDACTED]) positively identified via CO DL [REDACTED], who stated that they both witnessed CLINE hit BURGESS in the face. However both stated that once CLINE was outside they witnessed an unidentified male fighting with CLINE in the parking lot. Both SELHEIM-PHILPOTT and LARSON stated CLINE and the other male were punching each other, however the other male left when the police arrived and they did not know where he had gone.

Prior to leaving the call Sergeant Carlson entered the restroom and noticed another male in the one of the stalls. The male was making grunting noises and then sounded like he was grabbing toilet paper. Sergeant Carlson exited the restroom to wait for the male to exit. Sergeant Carlson stated that he did not hear a toilet flush, however he entered the re-entered the restroom and found the male out of the stall talking on his cell phone. The male was identified as SIMONES, Lee (DOB [REDACTED]) via CO DL [REDACTED]. SIMONES stated that he had been using the restroom and then decided to make a phone call, because it was quite in there. At this time the bar was closed and there was only minimal noise. SIMONES stated that he had witnessed CLINE punch his girlfriend BURGESS in the face. Throughout the entire investigation (approximately 45 minutes) no Officer saw SIMONES.

It was later reported to me by Corporal Martens that while CLINE was at the hospital he spit on a security guard, BEST, Sean (DOB [REDACTED])

CLINE was issued a citation (M1092605) for assault, assault, harassment, criminal mischief, disorderly conduct, and obstructing a Peace Officer or Firefighter.

Due to VONSEGGEN level of intoxication it appears that he was over served at the bar and I will follow up to issue FERRY a citation for over serves and failure to report the disturbances throughout the evening.

No employee of the bar called LPD throughout the evening, the original 911 call was make by SELHEIM-PHILPOTT.

On scene I obtained the bar tab for CLINE which listed 1 Budweiser, 1 Bud Light, 1 shot of Fireball, and 2 shots of Rupleminz.

On scene photographs were taken by Officer Jones and Officer Mannerings which have been submitted into LPD Evidence.

Prior to leaving the scene FERRY was able to place the door back on the hinges and stated that the computer seemed to be in working order.

After speaking to Commander Eyman he authorized the bond for CLINE to be raised from \$1000.00 to \$10000.00

When presented the citation FERRY stated that he was unaware that he needed to call the police for disturbances that occurred in the bar. I educated FERRY on the need to call the police for disturbances that occur within the establishment.
