9 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
10 COLORADO, AMENDING CITY CODE SECTIONS 10-3-2
11 AND 10-8-2 ALLOWING TATTOO PARLORS AND BODY
12 ARTS STUDIOS IN THE COMMUNITY BUSINESS
13 DISTRICT (B-2), GENERAL BUSINESS DISTRICT (B-3) AND
14 CENTRAL AREA MULTIPLE USE DISTRICT (CA) SUBJECT
15 TO CONDITIONAL USE APPROVAL

17 WHEREAS, the city council of the City of Littleton desires to allow tattoo parlors
18 and body arts studios in the Community Business District (B-2), General Business District (B-3) and
19 Central Area Multiple Use District (CA) after approval of a conditional use and subject to
20 limitations;

22 WHEREAS, the planning board, at its regular meeting on December 8, 2014 held a
23 public hearing and voted to table approval of an ordinance allowing tattoo parlors and body arts
24 studios in the B-2, B-3 and CA zone districts after approval of a conditional use and subject to
25 limitations; and

27 WHEREAS, the planning board, at its regular meeting of January 26, 2015 held a
28 public hearing and voted to recommend city council approve the ordinance allowing tattoo parlors
29 and body arts studios in the B-2, B-3 and CA zone districts after approval of a conditional use and
30 subject to limitations; and

32 WHEREAS, the city council finds that the proposed amendments are in the best
33 interest of the city and promote the public health, safety and welfare of its inhabitants;

35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
36 CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

38 Section 1: Littleton City Code Section 10-3-2 is hereby amended to add 11.17
39 "Tattoo parlors and body arts studios" as a conditional use in the B-2, B-3 and CA zone districts, as

Section 2: Littleton City Code Section 10-8-2 is amended by adding subsection (R) to read as follows:

(R) Tattoo parlors and body arts studios: Tattoo parlors and body arts studios may be permitted in the B-2, B-3 and CA districts subject to being no closer than 1,000 feet from another tattoo parlor or body arts studio within the city. The planning board may apply conditions to reduce the impact of the use on adjoining properties which may include, but not limited to, hours of operation, parking, outdoor lighting and security measures. All signage must comply with section 4-3-2-5 of this code.

Section 3: Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The city council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared invalid.

Section 4 : Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.
