7 A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL
8 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITIES OF LITTLETON AND
9 ENGLEWOOD, AND THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
10 HEALTH & ENVIRONMENT FOR A PER- AND POLYFLUOROALKYL
11 SUBSTANCES (“PFAS”) GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000

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13 WHEREAS, City Council may, by resolution, enter into contracts with other
14 government bodies to furnish or receive governmental services, to make or pay for charges for
15 such services and to enter into cooperative or joint activities with other government bodies; and

17 WHEREAS, the cities of Littleton and Englewood (the “Cities”) jointly own and
18 operate South Platte Renew (f/k/a., the Littleton/Englewood Wastewater Treatment Plant that
19 treats wastewater from the Cities and special connector districts that have contracted with one or
20 both Cities; and

22 WHEREAS, as part of that joint ownership and financial and environmental
23 stewardship, the City of Littleton wishes to approve the grant award from the Colorado Department
24 of Public Health & Environment for Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl substances.

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26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
27 THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

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29 Section 1: The City of Littleton approves the grant award from the Colorado
30 Department of Public Health & Environment for Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl substances.

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32 Section 2: The Resolution shall take effect upon its approval by the Littleton
33 City Council.
