Proclaiming October 1 through October 31, 2025
“LGBTQ+ History Month”
in the City of Littleton*

***WHEREAS**, 2025 marks the fifty-sixth anniversary of the Stonewall Rebellion, which marked the beginning of the modern gay and lesbian movement in the U.S.; and*

***WHEREAS**, anti-LGBTQ+ rhetoric and policies are advancing rapidly across the country, with a coordinated effort to prohibit transgender persons from obtaining accurate identity documents, receive healthcare, serve their country in the military, and to otherwise live a full life as their authentic selves; and*

***WHEREAS**, it is the role of government, on all levels, to foster safety, equality, and representation for all citizens; and*

***WHEREAS**, members of the LGBTQ+ community have made many important contributions to society including public health advocacy, political representation, scientific advancements, and creative expression through arts, culture, and entertainment; and*

***WHEREAS**, Littleton’s Q+ community began a local event, “Big Pride Littleton”, in 2024 with overwhelming participation and support from the community, with a second annual event scheduled on October 11, 2025; and*

***WHEREAS**, the City of Littleton is committed to fairness and the recognition of the full rights and responsibilities of all its citizens.*

***NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Kyle Schlachter, Mayor of the City of Littleton, do hereby proclaim the month of October 2025 as LGBTQ+ History Month” and <statement encouraging citizens to recognize/celebrate>.*
