

### GRANT AGREEMENTS \$950,000

## CHURCH ST. MULTIMODAL \$250,000

- Revitalizing Main Streets Opportunity Funds
- Total Project Cost: \$305,000
  - \$250,000 Grant Funds
  - \$55,000 matching funds from 3A Capital Improvements Fund
- IGA Approved by Council on March 5, 2024

## GREAT OUTDOORS COLORADO (GOCO)

\$950,000

- Reynolds Landing River & Park Improvements
- City Required to provide 25% Match
  - Will be included as part of the Open Space Fund 2025 Budget
- IGA Approved by Council on March 5, 2024

- No City funds are required or being appropriated





#### CAPITAL FUND

#### BOWELS AVENUE FENCE REPLACEMENT \$179,500

- Replacement of Fence Built in 1990s
  - New Fence Anticipated Lifespan: 50 years
- Upon completion, seeking ownership transfer to homeowners
- Funding Information
  - Appropriating \$179,500 from Capital Projects Fund
  - 2023 Building Use Tax revenues higher than anticipated







#### 3A SALES TAX FUND

## REPLACE SPRAY PATCH TRUCK WITH ASPHALT RECYCLER \$102,353

- Spray Patch Truck (Current)
  - Model Discontinued
  - High Operating Cost
- Asphalt Recycler (Replacement)
  - Uses the City's millings to operate reducing millings waste
  - Lower Operating Cost
  - Operates in Lower Temperatures
- Additional Info
  - Asphalt Recycler Purchase price: \$102,353
  - Aligns with 3A Sales Tax Capital Improvement Fund
  - Sale of previous vehicle (approx. \$50,000 \$60,000) will be receipted in 3A Fund



#### IMPACT FEE FUND

# ADDITIONAL IMPACT FEE APPROPRIATION \$849,349

- Additional revenue projected to be received in 2024 \$800,000
- Appropriating additional funds for transportation and multimodal projects \$49,349 from Fund Balance







#### SEWER FUND

# SOUTH PLATTE REVIEW OPERATIONS COMPLEX & ADMIN BUILDING \$900,000

- Continues funding plan from 2023 for the Operations Complex and Admin Building Remodel
- Due to unanticipated delays, unused funds from 2023 returned to the City
- Unused fund must be appropriated on an annual basis
- Project is expected to be completed this month (August 2024)

#### ALTERNATIVES

- Option 1 Approve the amendment to the 2024 budget to complete the projects and purchases.
- Option 2 Do not approve the amendment. The City will need to identify an alternative funding source to complete the projects and purchases. Funds from outside agencies and partners will be returned



#### RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of the ordinances on second reading to amend the Annual Appropriation, and the Littleton Sewer Utility Enterprise budget for 2024.
