Honorable Mayor and Council Members,

First off, I would like to give some props to the City for providing the lighted crosswalk across Littleton Blvd. The addition of these crossings is a great improvement and is a start to the needed improvements for the Littleton Boulevard corridor.

I was disappointed at the decision at the last CC meeting to defeat the Littleton Streetscape project. I understand that there are other pressing financial needs and priorities for the City and can accept that to some degree. However, Littleton Boulevard is the main artery to our beloved Downtown. If it does not scream "Littleton this way!", then we are losing a huge opportunity. This opportunity is gone for now but please keep in your head that Littleton Boulevard is and should be a top priority.

I was pleased to see the exchange that occurred in the CC and LIFT meeting. LIFT stands on its own but it was good to open the lines of communication between CC and LIFT. If CC can articulate a concise direction and vision to LIFT, then I have confidence LIFT will do what is in the best interest of the community.

There is a small but very loud group of citizens that is bent on disbanding LIFT and anything related to Urban Renewal. Please take note of who these people are and their demographic. They do not speak for Littleton's future, they are Littleton's past. They feel cheated by an Urban Renewal project some 35 years ago and can't let it go. They claim many things and are very outspoken, but they play on fear and scare tactics because they are scared. With this manufactured fear, they managed to get 300 passed so they could have a voice. That apparently was not enough for them and now they want the option gone altogether.

Of course, no one wants to have another fiasco. But there is no current project underway to cause concern. LIFT isn't harming anyone. Eminent domain is not even being discussed. If you become swayed into believing their hype, which it appears some of you are, you will be doing the future generation of Littleton a great disservice. Urban Renewal is a tool that is there to be used when the right occasion arises. I encourage you to consider this carefully and keep this tool for when that occasion does arise.

Lastly I wanted to comment on the marijuana. I understand the great tax revenue that can come of this. It is a booming industry. We saw the parking lot last CC meeting was full of a lot of very nice cars and the Council Chamber with very nice suits. Packaging, branding, etc, is irrelevant. With rec sales, it will now be available right down the street, and quite possibly on Main St! As a father with young children, I do not support this ordinance. Think about your kids, those of you that have them. Please vote no on this ordinance!

I could go on and on about the need for revitalization in Littleton but know your time is precious and will save that for another day. Thank you for your service to our community and making the hard decisions that need to be made.
