7 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
8 COLORADO, AUTHORIZING TWO APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING
9 FROM THE ARAPAHOE COUNTY OPEN SPACES GRANT PROGRAM
10 FOR 1) SANTA FE DRIVE REGIONAL TRAIL CONNECTION, AND 2)
11 COMMUNITY TRAIL CONNECTION

13 WHEREAS, the city of Littleton as part of its mission statement acquires and
14 improves land within city boundaries to develop and provide park and recreation facilities for the
15 public; and
16

17 WHEREAS, Arapahoe County provides funding for such projects through
18 distribution of its Open Space Grant monies; and
19

20 WHEREAS, the city of Littleton is requesting \$135,000 from Arapahoe County
21 Open Spaces to partially fund the design of the Santa Fe Drive Regional Trail Connection; and
22

23 WHEREAS, the city of Littleton is requesting \$135,000 from Arapahoe County
24 Open Spaces to partially fund the design of the Community Trail Connection
25

26 WHEREAS, all two projects are located within an outdoor open space open to
27 the public.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
30 THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:
31

32 Section 1. The City Council of the City of Littleton strongly supports the grant
33 applications to partially design 1) Santa Fe Drive Regional Trail Connection and 2) Community
34 Trail Connection.
35

36 Section 2. The City Council of city of Littleton has authorized sufficient
37 appropriation to cover the matching funds for the two projects and authorizes the expenditure of
38 funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of the awarded grant.
39

40 Section 3. The city commits to completing: 1) Santa Fe Drive Regional Trail
41 Connection and 2) Community Trail Connection.
42

43 Section 4. The project sites are owned by the city of Littleton.
44

45 Section 5. If the grant is awarded the city of Littleton acknowledges responsibility
46 of cost overruns for: 1) Santa Fe Drive Regional Trail Connection and 2) Community Trail

47 Connection.

49 **Section 6.** If the grant is awarded, the city council of the city of Littleton hereby
50 authorizes the city Manager to sign the grant agreement and grant records with Arapahoe County.

51

52 **Section 7.** This resolution is in full force and effect from and after its passage and
53 approval.
