NARRATIVE-INITIAL REPORT

ASSIGNMENT:

On 07/19/2025 at approximately 2041 hours, I was dispatched to a drunk subject at Angelo's Taverna 6885 S. Santa Fe Dr,

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INCIDENT REPORT

City of Littleton, County of Arapahoe, State of Colorado. INVESTIGATION: Upon arrival, I observed a female, later identified as Angie who appeared to be heavily intoxicated on the ground near the north parking lot. Officer Kingrey was already on scene and was helping Angle sit up. Angie's husband, Frank stated that she had consumed six shots of alcohol within a span of three hours and had very little to eat. He mentioned that she but had not consumed anything that could cause cross-contamination. Angle was resistant to receiving medical assistance, stating she did not want help from the EMT's. Despite her refusal, she was informed that the EMT's were already dispatched and would at least check her vitals. I spoke to an independent witness, Christopher who was on scene. Christopher stated the following: Christopher is from out of state and was sitting at the same bar that Angie and Frank were at. Christopher noticed that Angie seemed to be upset with her husband Frank, who appeared to be flirting with other women. Christopher noticed that Angie had consumed several drinks in a short span of time and did not eat food. Christopher encouraged Angie to order some food, and she eventually did. Angie did not eat the food, and it was packed in a to-go box that Frank had in his hand. Based on conversations Christopher heard, he believes that the reason Angie and Frank were allowed to buy and consume a lot of alcohol was because they knew the owners of Angelo's Taverna. Christopher does not know either Angie or Frank but was concerned for Angie's well-being which is why he stayed with her. Christopher provided the bartenders name as Chelsea. South Metro Fire Rescue arrived and began assessing Angie's condition. They confirmed that she had no visible injuries but were concerned about her level of intoxication given her small size and the amount of alcohol consumed. Angle is 5'01 and approximately 100lbs. Angie was transported to Littleton Hospital due to her level of intoxication. Frank got an Uber and stated he was going to go home. I spoke with the manager Justin Crawford who stated that he was the one that called to get Angie help. Staff confirmed that Angie and Frank were drinking at the bar and also bought shots for multiple people there. Staff also stated that they believed Angle and Frank needed to be cut off but they were overruled by management. Staff also mentioned that this is the second time in a month they have seen Angie and Frank at Angelo's Taverna and the prior time, they both were intoxicated I was provided a copy of the receipt for Frank and Angie. I observed that 17 drinks were ordered on their receipt which was timestamped at 1813 hours. A copy of this receipt will be included in this report.

NARRATIVE-SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT BY OFFICER VILLAGRANA:

On 07/24/2025 I went to speak to staff at Angelo's Taverna. Upon my arrival, I spoke to Walter Davis who stated he is a manager for the establishment. I asked him if the bartender, Chelsea, who was later positively identified as Chelsea Pratt was not at work. I told Davis that I wanted to speak further about the incident that took place on 07/19/2025.

I informed Davis that further investigation, including witness statements, indicated that Angie, the patron was over-served and that the bartender was responsible for serving the alcohol. I explained that Pratt would be issued a citation for over-serving alcohol. Davis stated that he was present during the incident and described the events leading up to the Angie's hospitalization. Davis noted that Angie and her companion ordered approximately 17 shots, some shots were distributed among other patrons. Despite management observing the group and interacting with them, the patron appeared fine while seated but lost equilibrium upon standing. Davis acknowledged that Angie was overserved and expressed willingness to take responsibility for the citation, citing his role in approving continued service.

I clarified that responsibility in this case is on the individual bartender who are typically trained to prevent over-serving. Davis expressed concern that the bartender may have felt pressured to comply with management's approval of continued service. I informed him that I would consult with my supervisor regarding his concerns but reiterated that the citation would still be issued to the bartender.

Davis expressed frustration with the situation but remained cooperative throughout the interaction. I told Davis that I understand that Pratt was only following what her manager told her to do but she is still responsible for serving the alcohol. I told Davis I understand why he wants to take responsibility for the incident to prevent Pratt from getting the citation but that was not possible.

Davis emphasized that he had addressed the incident with his staff, reassuring them that management holds ultimate responsibility for cutting off service to intoxicated patrons. He expressed a commitment to preventing similar incidents in the future.

Based on my investigation, I have sufficient evidence to cite both Davis and Pratt for 3-2-7(F) LPD - SALE OF ALCOHOL TO INTOXICATED PERSONS. I issued a citation to Davis (citation #LPDMUN251453) and explained the court date and procedure. Davis provided contact information for Pratt. Davis told me he wanted to call Pratt before I did so he can let her know that she wasn't going to lose her job. I agreed and told Davis I would wait to call Pratt until after he called her. I left Pratt a voicemail on the phone number provided by Davis Davis also stated he would go to LPD Headquarters with Pratt to pick up the citation.

As of the time of this report, Pratt has not contacted me back nor picked up the citation. The citation has been placed in the TO BE SERVED box and will be ready for Pratt to pickup.

On my days off I received a voicemail from a male who verbally identified himself as Craig Jones and stated that he was the owner of Angelo's Taverna. I called Jones who expressed concerns about the citation and emphasized the experience and judgment of his staff. He stated that the decision to serve the female additional drinks was made after assessing her condition, which appeared fine at the time. Jones stated that if a staff member is concerned that someone is too intoxicated, they seek guidance from a manager. Jones elaborated on his experience as a restaurant owner and that of his managers. Jones expressed frustration with his establishment being cited.

I clarified that the citation was issued to individuals, not the establishment itself but did state that the city may do their own investigation in addition to ours. I also provided the municipal code and explained the basis for the citation. The owner indicated his intention to contact city council members and the mayor to discuss the matter further and have a "fair hearing." Jones also stated that he "would love" for me to share this with the mayor and city council. I explained to Jones that the reports and recordings are available to city staff. Jones asked me multiple times if I was recording to which I told him I was. Jones then asked to speak to my supervisor. LPD Dispatch transferred Jones to Cpl. Dimock's phone.
