11 public funds, to manage its finances wisely, and to plan for the adequate funding of services desired

14 **WHEREAS**, the city council desires to establish guidelines and financial policies
15 to foster and support the continued financial strength and stability of the City of Littleton; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the city council desires to promote transparency in the management
18 of grant funding by providing specific principles that will be applied to the management of grant
19 funds to enable the public to have confidence in the city’s use of external resources; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the city council desires to align the pursuit of external resources with
22 community priorities in order to provide beneficial, meaningful and valued services and programs,
23 while incorporating the necessary investment to maintain and develop the value in community
24 assets.

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF**
27 **THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

29 1. The Littleton City Council hereby adopts the Grant Policy attached to this
30 resolution.

32 2. The City Manager and Finance Director are authorized to adopt such
33 administrative procedures and practices to implement the Grant Policy.
