**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
COLORADO, APPROVING AN IGA BETWEEN THE COLORADO
DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES AND THE LITTLETON POLICE
DEPARTMENT FOR CO-RESPONDER PROGRAMS**

WHEREAS, the Littleton Police Department seeks to provide valuable crisis intervention services to community members experiencing mental health crises; and

WHEREAS, the Littleton Police Department operates a Co-Responder Program in partnership with AllHealth Network that utilizes licensed mental health clinicians and crisis case managers to provide immediate mental health services to community members experiencing mental health crises; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Human Services has provided grant funding to the Littleton Police Department to offset costs associated with the department's Co-Responder Program; and

WHEREAS, the Littleton Community benefits from the Co-Responder Program's ability to provide essential crisis intervention services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

The Intergovernmental Agreement between the Colorado Department of Human Services and the Littleton Police Department for Co-Responder Programs is hereby approved.
