A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE 17-2020 AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE LITTLETON CITY CODE WITH THE INTENT OF CLARIFYING DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AND IMPROVING PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT PROCESSES

WHEREAS, the Littleton City Code establishes processes and procedures for amendments as may be necessary from time to time;

WHEREAS, the Littleton City Council directed city staff to prepare amendments to the Littleton City Code to help address several inconsistencies between the Littleton City Code and the Envision Littleton Comprehensive Plan related to public engagement, development regulations, allowed uses, and parking; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2020, the Planning Commission held a public hearing to consider the proposed ordinance and a recommendation thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The Planning Commission of the City of Littleton finds that the proposed Ordinance 17-2020 promotes the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Littleton.

Section 2. The Planning Commission of the City of Littleton hereby recommends approval of proposed Ordinance 17-2020.
