7 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
8 COLORADO, APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO A
9 SUBRECIPIENT GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF
10 LITTLETON AND BRIDGE HOUSE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,500,000 IN
11 SUPPORT OF THE TRI-CITIES READY TO WORK PROGRAM

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13 WHEREAS, the parties have previously entered into an Agreement and desire to
14 make amendments to adjust the period of performance and frequency of reporting; and

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16 WHEREAS, the City of Littleton was awarded a FY23 Community Project
17 Funding grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on behalf of Bridge
18 House to be used for the Tri-Cities Ready to Work program; and

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20 WHEREAS, development and implementation of the Ready to Work program was
21 prescribed by the 2021 Tri-Cities Homeless Action Plan unanimously adopted by City Council

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
25 THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

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27 Section 1. the City of Littleton hereby approves the first amendment to a
28 subrecipient grant agreement between the City of Littleton and Bridge House in the amount of
29 \$1,500,000 in support of the Tri-Cities Ready to Work program to adjust the period of performance
30 and frequency of reporting.
