14 15 16	<b>WHEREAS</b> , an urban renewal plan for the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Area has been submitted to the City Council of the City of Littleton for appropriate action, pursuant to Part 1 of Article 25 of Title 31, C.R.S.;
17 18	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Area, which is subject to the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan, is described in Exhibit A to this Resolution;
19 20 21 22	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan has previously been submitted to the City of Littleton Planning Board for its review and recommendation as to conformity with the general plan for development of the municipality in accordance with C.R.S. § 31-25-107(2);
23 24 25	WHEREAS, the City of Littleton Planning Board has determined that the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan does conform to the City of Littleton's general plan for development;
26 27 28	<b>WHEREAS</b> , no property in the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan has been included in an urban renewal plan previously submitted to and not approved by the City Council of the City of Littleton within the previous twenty four (24) months;
29 30 31 32	<b>WHEREAS</b> , notice of the time, place, and purpose of the public hearing to consider the adoption of the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan was published in the Littleton Independent, a newspaper of general circulation within the City, at least thirty (30) days before the public hearing in conformance with C.R.S. § 31-25-107(3);
33 34 35 36	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the City of Littleton has provided written notice of the public hearing to consider the adoption of the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan to all property owners, residents, and business owners within the proposed Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan Area at their last known address in conformance with C.R.S. § 31-25-107(4)(c);
37	WHEREAS, the Arapahoe County Commissioners have received notification of

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and copies of the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan, as well as such additional information
as is required by C.R.S. § 31-25-107(3.5);

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Littleton has considered the
Columbine Square Conditions Survey prepared by Ricker/Cunningham and the proposed
Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan; and

  hearing and considered the public testimony received.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

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49 **Section 1:** Blight, as defined by C.R.S. § 31-25-103(2), is present in the 50 Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan Area, as documented by the Columbine Square 51 Conditions Survey prepared by Ricker/Cunningham and based on additional evidence presented 52 at the public hearing. All of the blight factors as set forth in C.R.S. § 31-25-103(2) are present 53 within the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan Area.

54 **Section 2:** The Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan Area is a blighted 55 area and is appropriate for an urban renewal project pursuant to Part 1 of Article 25 of Title 31, 56 C.R.S. 57

58 Section 3: Based on the evidence presented at the public hearing, the City
59 Council of the City of Littleton hereby further finds and determines that:

(a) To the extent applicable, there exist feasible methods for the relocation of
 individuals, families, and business concerns in accommodations or areas suitable for their
 relocation.

(b) The City Council has taken reasonable efforts to provide written notice of the
public hearing to all property owners, residents and owners of business concerns in the
proposed urban renewal area at their last known address of record at least thirty days
prior to the hearing. Such notice contained the information required by C.R.S. § 31-25107(3).

- (c) No more than 120 days have passed since the commencement of the first public
  hearing of the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan.
- 74 (d) The Columbine Square Renewal Plan does not contain property that was included
   75 in a previously submitted urban renewal plan that the City Council failed to approve.
   76
- 77 (e) The Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan conforms to the general plan of the

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78 City of Littleton as a whole. 79 80 The Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan will afford maximum opportunity, (f) 81 consistent with the sound needs of the City of Littleton as a whole, for the rehabilitation 82 or redevelopment of the urban renewal area by private enterprise. 83 84 The Littleton Invests for Tomorrow Urban Renewal Authority or the City of (g) 85 Littleton will adequately finance any additional county infrastructure and services 86 required to serve development in the urban renewal area during the applicable tax 87 increment financing period as set forth in C.R.S. § 31-25-107(9)(a)(II). 88 89 The principal purpose for the adoption of the Columbine Square Urban Renewal (h) 90 Plan is to facilitate redevelopment in order to eliminate or prevent the spread of 91 physically blighted areas. 92 93 The boundaries of the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan Area have been (i) 94 drawn as narrowly as feasible to accomplish the planning and development objectives for 95 the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan. 96 97 (j) The Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan does not consist in its entirety of 98 open land. 99 100 (k) The acquisition, clearance, rehabilitation, conservation, development or 101 redevelopment or a combination thereof of the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan, 102 pursuant to the Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan, is necessary and in the best 103 interests of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of the City of 104 Littleton. 105 106 Section 4: Based on the above findings, the City Council approves the 107 Columbine Square Urban Renewal Plan dated November, 4 2014. From and after the date of 108 adoption of this Resolution, the real property described within the Columbine Square Urban 109 Renewal Plan shall, for all purposes, be subject to the provisions of the Columbine Square Urban 110 Renewal Plan. 111 112 113 INTRODUCED, READ AND ADOPTED at a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council of the City of Littleton, Colorado, on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2014, at 6:30 p.m. at 114 115 the Littleton Center, 2255 West Berry Avenue, Littleton, Colorado. 116
