### Back Country Joint Response Area (BCJRA) Plans

#### WILDLAND LEVEL 1 JOINT RESPONSE – WL1 - BCJRA

The following response would be initiated for one of the following incident types occurring in the defined Back Country Joint Response area:

- INVESTIGATION – SMOKE OUTSIDE
- FIRE – BRUSH SMALL (Brush Small *defined as ¼ acres or less*)
  - During Red Flag fire conditions, all responses shall be dispatched as FIRE – BRUSH LARGE
