9 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,**
10 **COLORADO, AUTHORIZING AN**
11 **INTERGOVERNMENTAL ADDENDUM TO**
12 **WASTEWATER CONNECTOR'S AGREEMENT FOR**
13 **DISTRICTS BETWEEN BOW MAR WATER AND**
14 **SANITATION DISTRICT, COLUMBINE WATER AND**
15 **SANITATION DISTRICT, GRANT WATER AND**
16 **SANITATION DISTRICT, MEADOWBROOK FAIRVIEW**
17 **METROPOLITAN DISTRICT, PLATTE CANYON WATER**
18 **AND SANITATION DISTRICT, ROXBOROUGH PARK**
19 **METROPOLITAN DISTRICT, SOUTHWEST WATER AND**
20 **SANITATION DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF LITTLETON,**
21 **COLORADO**

23 **WHEREAS**, the City of Littleton owns and operates a sewage system, including
24 a sewage treatment plant which is jointly owned and operated with the City of Englewood
25 known as the L/E Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP); and

26
27 **WHEREAS**, the L/E WWTP provides sanitary sewer service to districts outside
28 of the Littleton corporate boundaries through a standard connector's agreement; and

29
30 **WHEREAS**, the L/E WWTP conducts an Industrial Pretreatment program to
31 control industrial/commercial wastes entering the wastewater collection and treatment system;
32 and

34 **WHEREAS**, the L/E WWTP Industrial Pretreatment Program is designed to
35 prevent pass through of pollutants to the South Platte River, protect the collection and treatment
36 system from damage, protect the public and worker health and safety, and improve opportunities
37 to recycle and reclaim municipal and industrial wastewaters and sludge; and

39 **WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Littleton authorized an
40 Intergovernmental Wastewater Connector's Agreement for Districts between Bow Mar Water
41 and Sanitation District, Columbine Water and Sanitation District, Grant Water and Sanitation
42 District, Meadowbrook Fairview Metropolitan District, Platte Canyon Water and Sanitation
43 District, Roxborough Park Metropolitan District, Southwest Water and Sanitation District and
44 the City of Littleton by the passage of Ordinance No. ____, Series of 20__; and

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46 **WHEREAS**, The L/E WWTP Industrial Pretreatment Program is subject to
47 Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) oversight and approval; and

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2 **WHEREAS**, the EPA conducted an audit of the L/E WWTP Industrial
3 Pretreatment Program on February 24, 2014 through February 27, 2014; and
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5 **WHEREAS**, the EPA identified that the current Pretreatment program
6 administered by the L/E WWTP does not have the legal framework to fully implement the
7 Pretreatment Regulations in the 19 outside contributing jurisdictions in its service area because
8 the Intergovernmental Connector's Agreement does not provide adequate delegation of the
9 Pretreatment program implementation to the cities of Littleton and Englewood; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the EPA required a corrective action that the L/E WWTP update the
12 Intergovernmental Wastewater Connector's Agreement Ordinance No. ___, Series of 20___, to
13 establish delegation for implementation of the Pretreatment Regulations, the passage of this
14 Ordinance the Addendum to Wastewater Connector's Agreement responds to EPA's corrective
15 action requirements by establishing delegation for implementation of the Pretreatment
16 Regulations within the District; and

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF**
19 **THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

21 **Section 1:** The Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Littleton
22 and Bow Mar Water and Sanitation District, Columbine Water and Sanitation District, Grant
23 Water and Sanitation District, Meadowbrook Fairview Metropolitan District, Platte Canyon
24 Water and Sanitation District, Roxborough Park Metropolitan District, Southwest Water and
25 Sanitation District entitled "Addendum to Wastewater Connector's Agreement" is hereby
26 approved; a copy is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

28 **Section 2:** Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or
29 phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the
30 validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it
31 would have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or
32 phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences,
33 clauses or phrases may be declared invalid.

35 **Section 3:** Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in
36 conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the
37 repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.

40 of the City of Littleton on the 4th day of April, 2017, passed on first reading by a vote of ___
41 FOR and ___ AGAINST; and ordered published by posting at Littleton Center, Bemis Library,

the Municipal Courthouse and on the City of Littleton Website.
