Council Member Cernanec moved and Council Member Clark seconded to amend the main motion to be contingent on receiving unrestricted access to allow for repairs over time in conjunction with ownership. Vote on the amendment to the main motion is 2-4, with Mayor Beckman, Mayor Pro Tem Brinkman, Council Member Clark, and Council Member Valdes voting no. The amendment to the main motion fails.
