11	WHEREAS, the city has owned Geneva Village since 1975;
12	
13	WHEREAS, rental rates at Geneva Village have not been increased since 1979
14	and are considerably lower than rates at other apartment communities in the city and the
15	surrounding Denver metro area; and
16	
17	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the current monthly rental rates of \$300 for a studio, \$395 for a one-
18 19	bedroom, and \$450 for a two bedroom unit are inadequate to cover expenses and results in the City's general fund subsidizing the operations, maintenance, and repairs at Geneva Village; and
20	City's general fund subsidizing the operations, maintenance, and repairs at Geneva vinage, and
21	WHEREAS, this resolution seeks to not increase rents on current residents at this
22	time, but instead raise the rental rates when vacancies occur; and
23	time, out instead faile and fondal faces when vacanoies occur, and
24	WHEREAS, the city council has determined that it is in the best interest of the
25	city to increase rental rates to begin to establish a reserve for future improvement expenses at
26	Geneva Village;

28	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
29	THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

31	Effective immediately and only when a rental unit at Geneva Village becomes vacant, the
32	new apartment rental rates for re-leasing purposes shall be increased as follows:
