9 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,**  
10 **COLORADO, APPROVING THE FIFTH AMENDMENT TO**  
11 **LEASE BETWEEN THE CITY OF LITTLETON AND**  
12 **WELLS FARGO BANK, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION**

13  
14 **WHEREAS**, the city of Littleton is a home rule municipality that operates a  
15 combined fire communications and dispatch center known as the Littleton Fire Rescue  
16 Communications Center; and

17  
18 **WHEREAS**, MetCom is a bureau of South Metro Fire Rescue operated to  
19 provide emergency services communications, dispatch services, and technology support for  
20 South Metro and other contracting parties; and

21  
22 **WHEREAS**, the city of Littleton and its fire partners (Highlands Ranch Metro  
23 District, Littleton Fire Protection District and Cunningham Fire Protection District) wish to  
24 contract emergency services dispatch with MetCom through South Metro Fire Rescue; and

25  
26 **WHEREAS**, the city council finds it to be in the best interest of the health, safety  
27 and welfare of the citizens to contract emergency dispatch services; and

28  
29 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF**  
30 **THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

31  
32 **Section 1: Terms and Termination;** The Intergovernmental Agreement  
33 is hereby approved effective August 1, 2017 and terminating December 31, 2021.

35 Either party may terminate this agreement with or without cause upon  
36 twelve (12) months' written notice

37  
38 **Section 2: Scope of Services:** MetCom shall provide primary  
39 emergency call handling and dispatch services to the City, Cunningham, Littleton  
40 Fire, and the Metro District through the MetCom Dispatch Center, as further  
41 described on **Exhibit A**, attached hereto and incorporated herein. The City,  
42 Cunningham, Littleton Fire, and the Metro District may each, in its sole  
43 discretion, provide run cards to MetCom that establish specific procedures and  
44 guidelines for dispatch of fire suppression, emergency medical, and specialty

1 units, including automatic and mutual aid. MetCom shall comply with any such  
2 run cards.

3 **Section 4: Compensation:** Amount. In consideration of the services  
4 to be performed pursuant to this Agreement, the City shall (i) pay the amounts set  
5 forth in Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein; and (ii) transfer title to  
6 the equipment described in Exhibit B to MetCom by an ordinance passed by the  
7 Littleton City Council. The City shall be liable to MetCom for making payment  
8 for the services provided to Cunningham, Littleton Fire, and the Metro District  
9 pursuant to the Littleton Service Agreements regardless of whether the City  
10 receives payment for such services.

13 INTRODUCED AS A BILL at a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council  
14 of the City of Littleton on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2017, passed on first reading by a vote of 6 FOR  
15 and 1 AGAINST; and ordered published by posting at Littleton Center, Bemis Library, the  
16 Municipal Courthouse and on the City of Littleton Website.

17 PUBLIC HEARING on the Ordinance to take place on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2017,  
18 in the Council Chambers, Littleton Center, 2255 West Berry Avenue, Littleton, Colorado, at the  
19 hour of 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as it may be heard.
